

The Legal Controls for Time Endowment

The researcher defined Endowment of time as: A temporary detention of human effort for the benefit of a favor well known charity. He touched upon some of its pictures, talked about its legitimate, the objections on it, and the answer to those objections, prevailing its legality, showing the reasons for prevailing. The general evidences of Waqf are causes to prove its legality. He also. Considered that Endowment of time is illegal if connected with profits as declared from conclusive evidence. Finally, he concluded the research with the legal controls to Waqf of time as shown below:

The first control: That the Waqf of time should be based on a real Waqf.

The second control: That the endowment showed have a legitimate value

The third control: The existence of a tributary to the endowment of time, from which the waqf derives its continuity.

The fourth control: Waqf of time should be out of sins.

The fifth control: That the endowment is for an entity that has a nominal value.

The sixth control: The endowment must be owned by the endower

The seventh control: A donator should be the one who has the right to donate.

The eighth control: That the Endower should be perfecting the benefit of the endowment

The ninth control: The suspended work must be known

The tenth control: Waqf time should not benefit the endower.
