



*A farmer had four lazy sons. They never worked nor did they do anything useful. This father was a hardworking man. He loved his job.*




*Every time he saw his sons he felt sorry because he wanted them to be hardworking farmers, like him, so he thought of a trick to teach his sons the value of work.*





*“Years ago, an enchanted eagle appeared in our town. One day that eagle caught a big snake and flew over our farm”, said the father.*




*“The big snake, however, managed to overcome the enchanted eagle. So they both turned into gold and diamonds and were buried in our farm.”*
