*Ashhadu An La Ilaha Ila Allah, Ashhadu An La Ilaha Ila Allah: (I testify that there is no truly worshipped God but Allah, I testify that there is no truly worshipped God but Allah);*

*Allahu Akbar, Allahu Akbar: (Allah is the Greatest. Allah is the Greatest);*

*La Ilaha Illa Allah: (There is no truly worshipped God but Allah).*

‘Abdullah, son of Zayd, went out towards the Messenger of Allah, *peace, and blessings of Allah be upon him*, then told him what he had seen. The Messenger of Allah ﷺ

You should have an inner power, not like someone else. Because what you want will not be suitable for another person.

## **Fifthly: Control Your Objectives**



So as not to lose your objectives, control it. Because of the long-term goal might get bored. So, do not tend to get tired so as not to continue hardly. It would be best if you divided your objective into several parties.

Make each part has time to achieve it. Then, give yourself a review and write down what you did complete it as well as what you did not reach it. Perhaps you need to change your path if you discover that.

## **Sixthly: Hopelessness**



Do not give up! Hopelessness is the arch-enemy.

**Hope for the best and prepare for the worst<sup>1</sup>.**

Remain optimistic, but make sure that you are mentally or physically prepared to cope with failure or disaster. Keep in mind the saying of *Edward Howard*: (**The youngest of us cannot always escape—hoping, trusting, relying on the best, we should be prepared for the worst**).

Besides, you will face many difficulties, so keep on your determination to reach the goal. It is the middle of success. On the contrary, if you have hopelessness because you failed, it means that you are in the middle of the failure.

So, how can I practise to clutch at hope?

*And I could wish my days to be.*
