

The king went out on his horse. On his way, he saw a shepherd looking after his sheep. The king was very thirsty. He came near the shepherd and asked him for a glass of milk.



The Sleeping Goose



The frogs lived peacefully and safely in their lake, ever after.






The Deer And The Fox


