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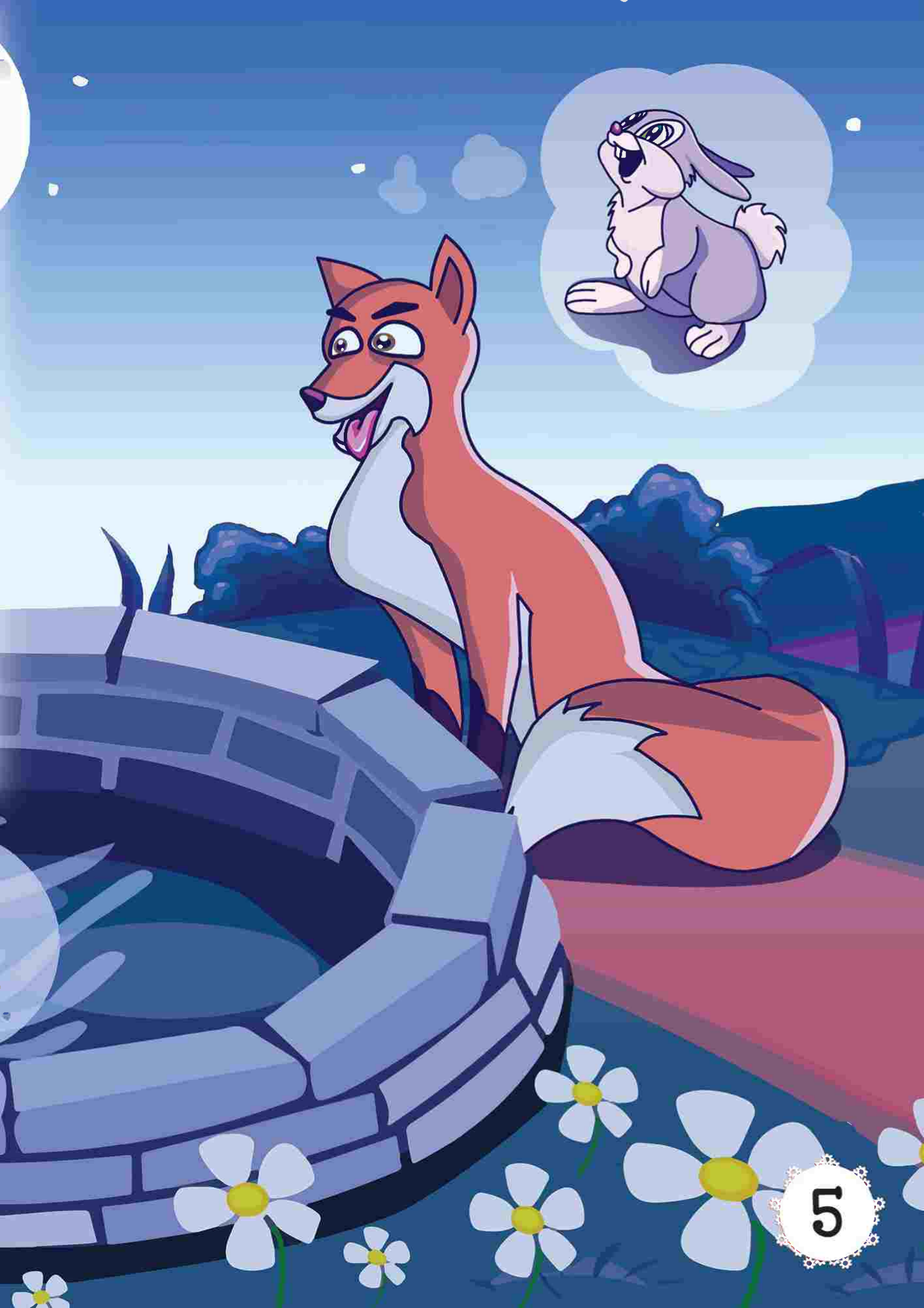
The Turtle And The Fox

The Clever Fish

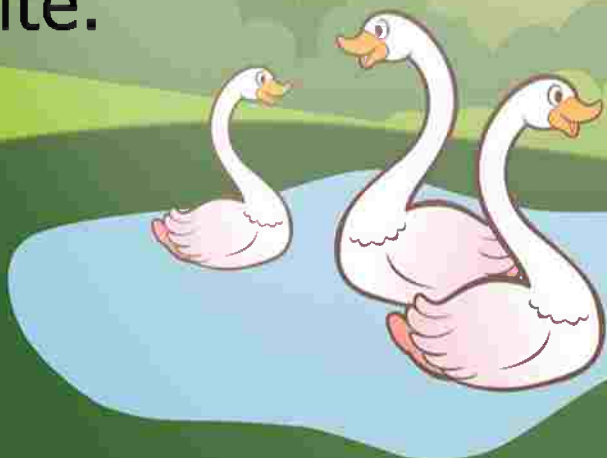

Glossary

The turtle and the fox:

The clever fish:

Full moon: The moon when it appears in the sky as a full lighted circle.

The greedy bee:
