


The Duck's Guard


The duck was walking along the lake when she saw an egg on the sand. She thought that it was one of her eggs. She rolled it over the sand and put it beside the rest of her eggs.

The Sad Tree






The Sweet Seller

Glossary

The shepherd's daughter:

Disguise: to change one's appearance in order to hide one's own reality.

Meadows: a large piece of land in which green grass grows. Animals such as goats and sheep feed on this grass.

The ducks' guard:

Alake: a large area full of water and surrounded by land from all sides.

The fat chick:

Barn: a place surrounded by wood, wire or trees where cattle and poultry are kept so as not to run away. This place protects the animals from cold and hot weather as well as wild animals.

The feast gift:

Fireplace or an electric heater: a device that makes us warm and protects us from cold by using coal (in the past) or electricity (at present)

The sweet seller:

Palace: a high luxurious building surrounded by high fence. It has plenty of rooms and gates. The ruler (King or prince) of a country live in it.

The Queen of Ice:

Kingdom: a place where many people live and ruled by a man called a king; his wife is called a queen.

Ice: Hard crystals or glass like pieces formed when water is exposed to very cold temperature.
