Dear M. Al Sabbagh

I apologize for the delay to answer your letter dated April 21.

As a matter of fact I wonder what to say about your research on operationalization of the Non Governmental role in Education. The above matter is quite large, and my experience is restricted to my knowledge of Caritas Internationalis network only. Caritas Internationalis is involved in many actions in favour of migrants, displaced persons, unfavoured youth, etc ... It therefore initiates educational activities in various part of the word further to emergency situations.

As an example we presently try to re-open schools in Albania or in Bosnia and have young people working together in a renewed spirit of mutual tolerance.

Another example was teaching in refugees camps after Rwanda's genocide.

In all such cases Caritas Internationalis works from his own. If, therefore, it takes operational role in Education, it is not further to a governmental decision but to the imperious necessity to do something when everything is to be restored.

However it must be mentioned that Caritas Internationalis cooperates with international organizations as HCR or UNICEF and cooperation agreements are nowadays contemplated.

But in no ways Educational tasks are « subcontracted » to Caritas Internationalis. It is therefore impossible for us to speak of operationalization of our activities even when they are effective.

Perhaps other NGO - such as « Office International de l'Enseignement Catholique » are closer to the definition of your research - but I am not competent to comment their own activities.

I am therefore sorry to be in such a poor situation to answer your query. However I found a few documents at UNESCO's library which might be of interest for you and take the liberty to join them hereattached.
