Amendment No. 40, for the year 1949
of the Regulations of
The Iraq Academy,
No. 62, for the year 1947.

Pursuant to Paragraph 6 of Article 1 of the Public Education Law No. 57, for the year 1940, and as submitted by the Minister of Education and approved by the Council of Ministers, we hereby order the Promulgation of the following Regulations:—

Article 1.

The word مساعدون (for "Associate", mentioned in Paragraph B of Article 5 shall be omitted & replaced by the word مؤازرون

Article 2.

- (1) The word المساعد (for "Associate") mentioned in Par. (1) of Article 7 shall be omitted & replaced by the word المؤازر
- (2) Par. (2) of Article 7 shall be omitted and replaced by the following:

"(2) In electing an honorary member, the following shall be observed:

That he be of good repute and well-known for his readiness to offer valuable aid in the encouragement of arts and sciences."

Article 3.

Article 11 shall be cancelled and replaced by the following:

"Active members shall meet to elect, by secret ballot and a simple majority of the members present, a President and two Vice-Presidents, who shall constitute the President's office.

Article 4

Article 9 shall be cancelled and replaced by the following:

"Active, associate, honorary and corresponding members shall be elected by secret ballot and a simple majority of those present, after nomination by two active members."

Article 5.

Article 14 shall be cancelled and replaced by the following:

"An active member shall be deemed to have resigned if he absent himself from six meetings, consecutive or otherwise, in one year, without a reason considered acceptable by the Academy."

Article 6.

Article 24 shall be cancelled and replaced by the following:

"The President and the active members shall each receive a fixed monthly allowance, decided upon by the Minister of Education in agreement with the Minister of Finance, provided that, should there be among them Government officials, the provisions of the Civil Service Law be observed."

Article 7.

Article 25 shall be cancelled.

Article 8.

Article 26 shall be cancelled and replaced by the following:

"A quorum shall be attained by the presence of more than half of the members, and decisions shall be taken by a majority vote of the members present. As for the meeting held according to the provisions of Article 9 of these Regulations, the meeting shall be held only if the number of members present is not less than two-thirds of the total number of active members. A copy of the decisions shall be sent to the Minister of Education for information."

Article 9.

These Regulations shall come into force as from the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

Article 10.

The Minister of Education is charged with the execution of these Regulations.
