Smart Sawsan

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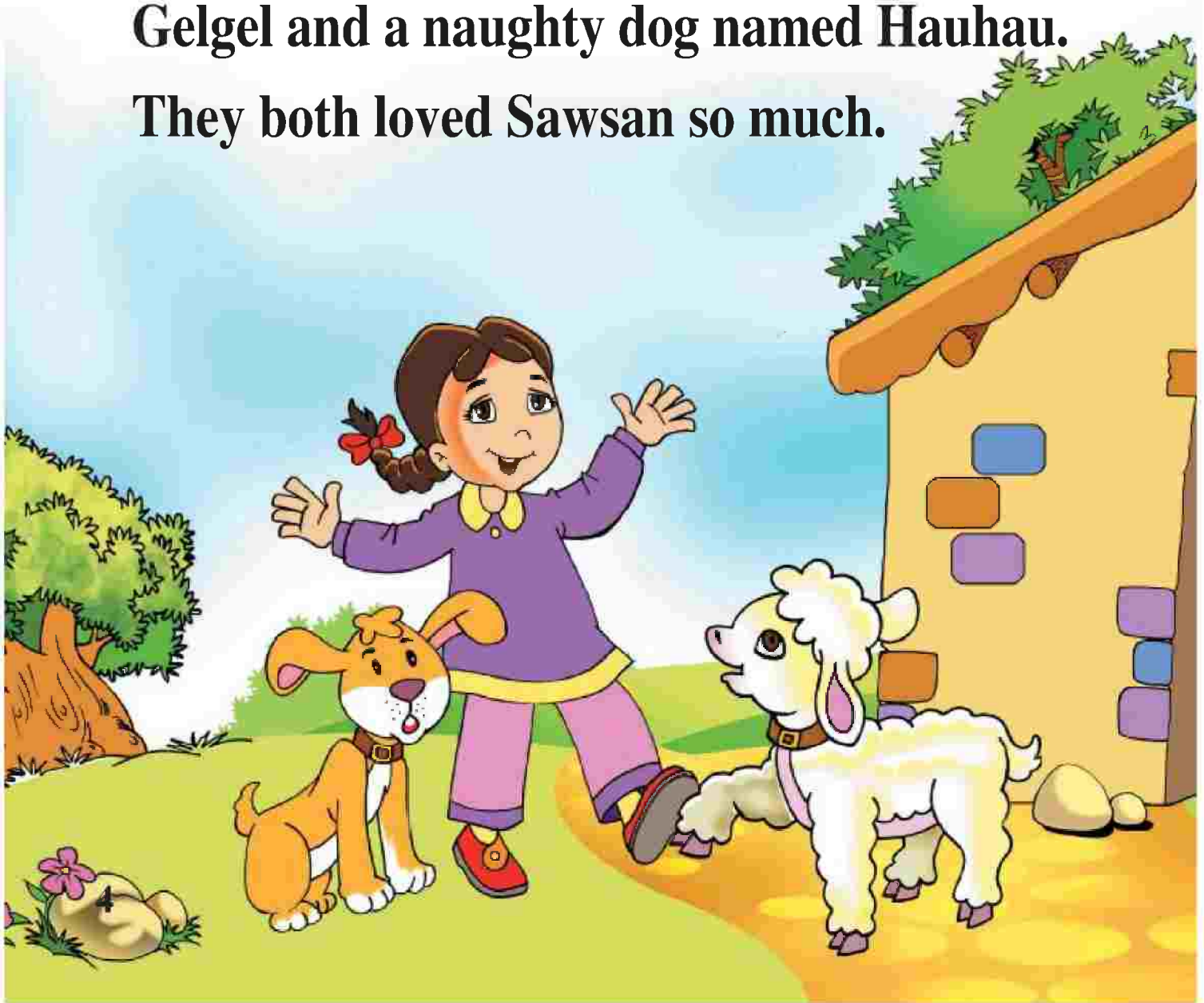
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Sawsan is a smart little girl living with her family in a pretty village house. The house is beside a small pond.

They both loved Sawsan so much.**



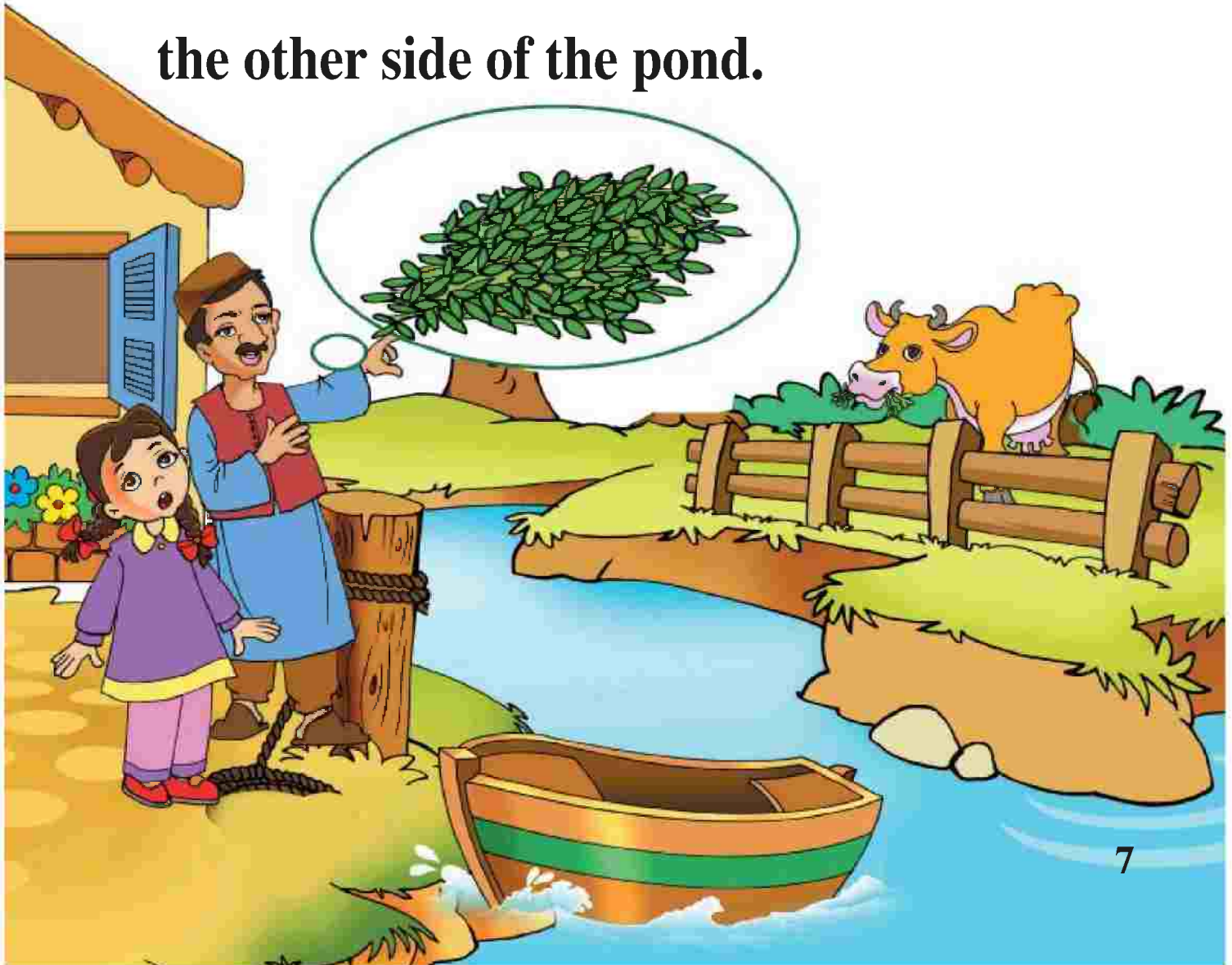
**Hauhau was always chasing Gelgel who

small.**



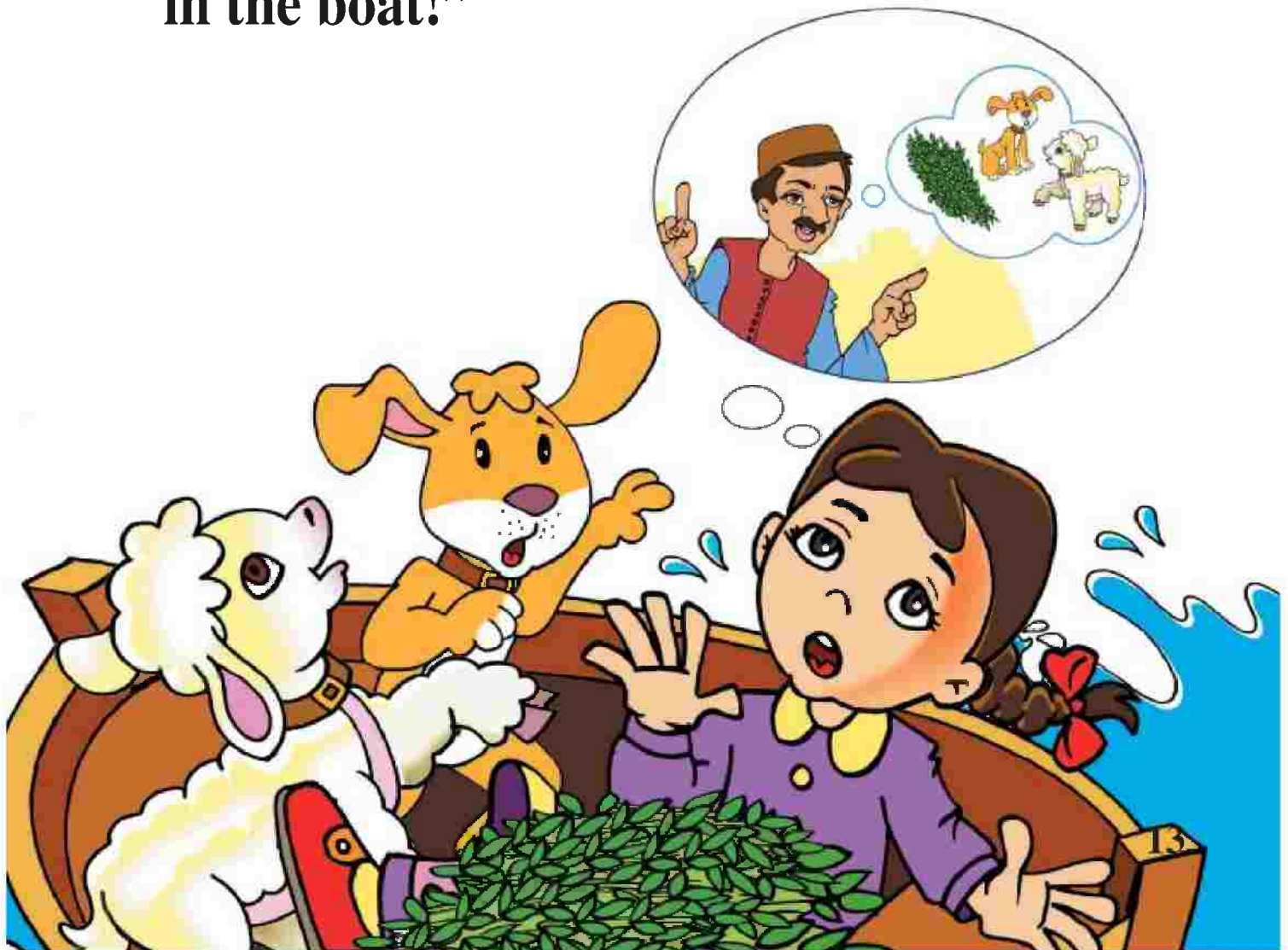
**Suddenly, Gelgel jumped into the boat

pond leaving the clover behind.**

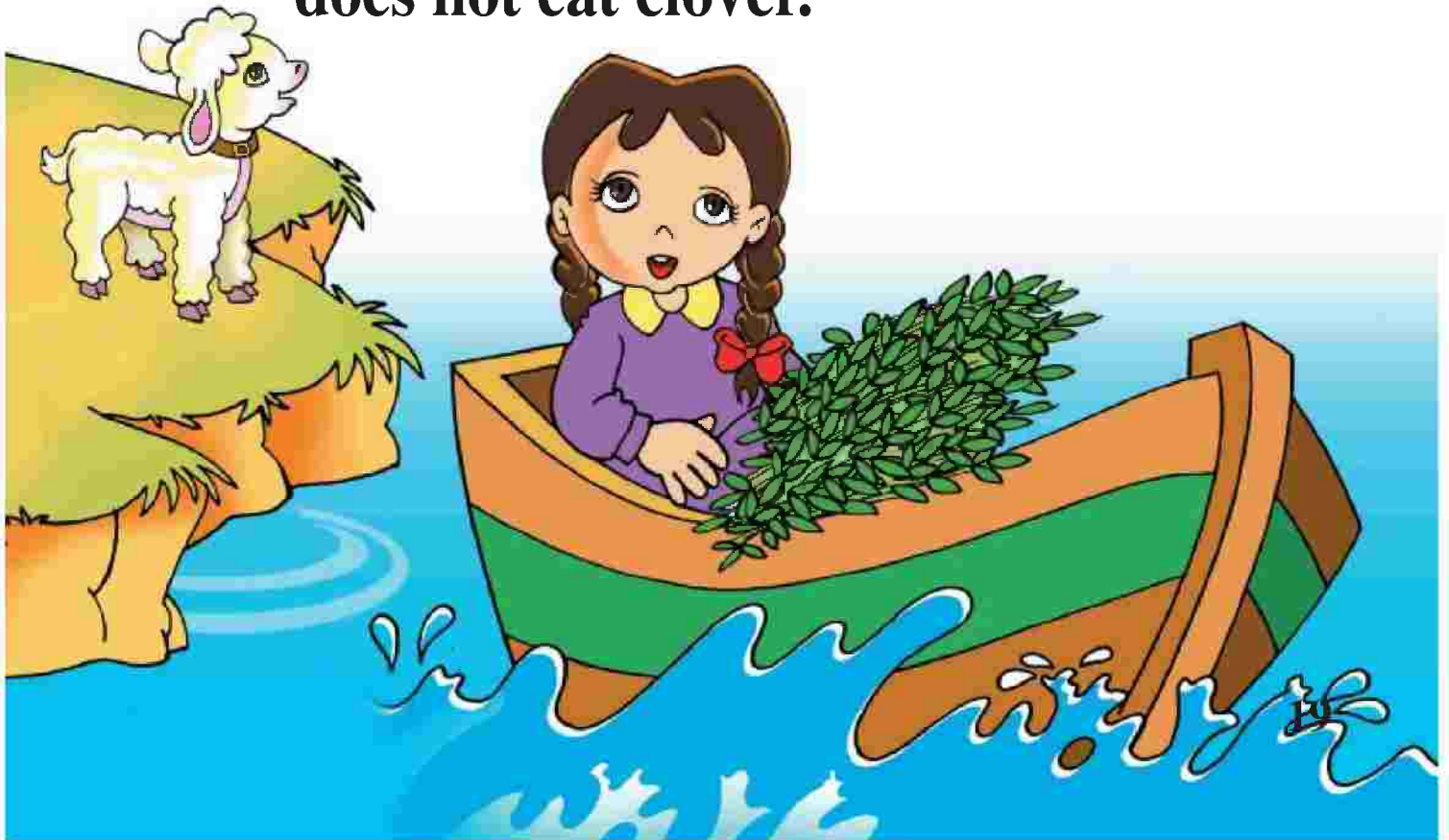
**Hauhau doesn't eat clover so the cow's

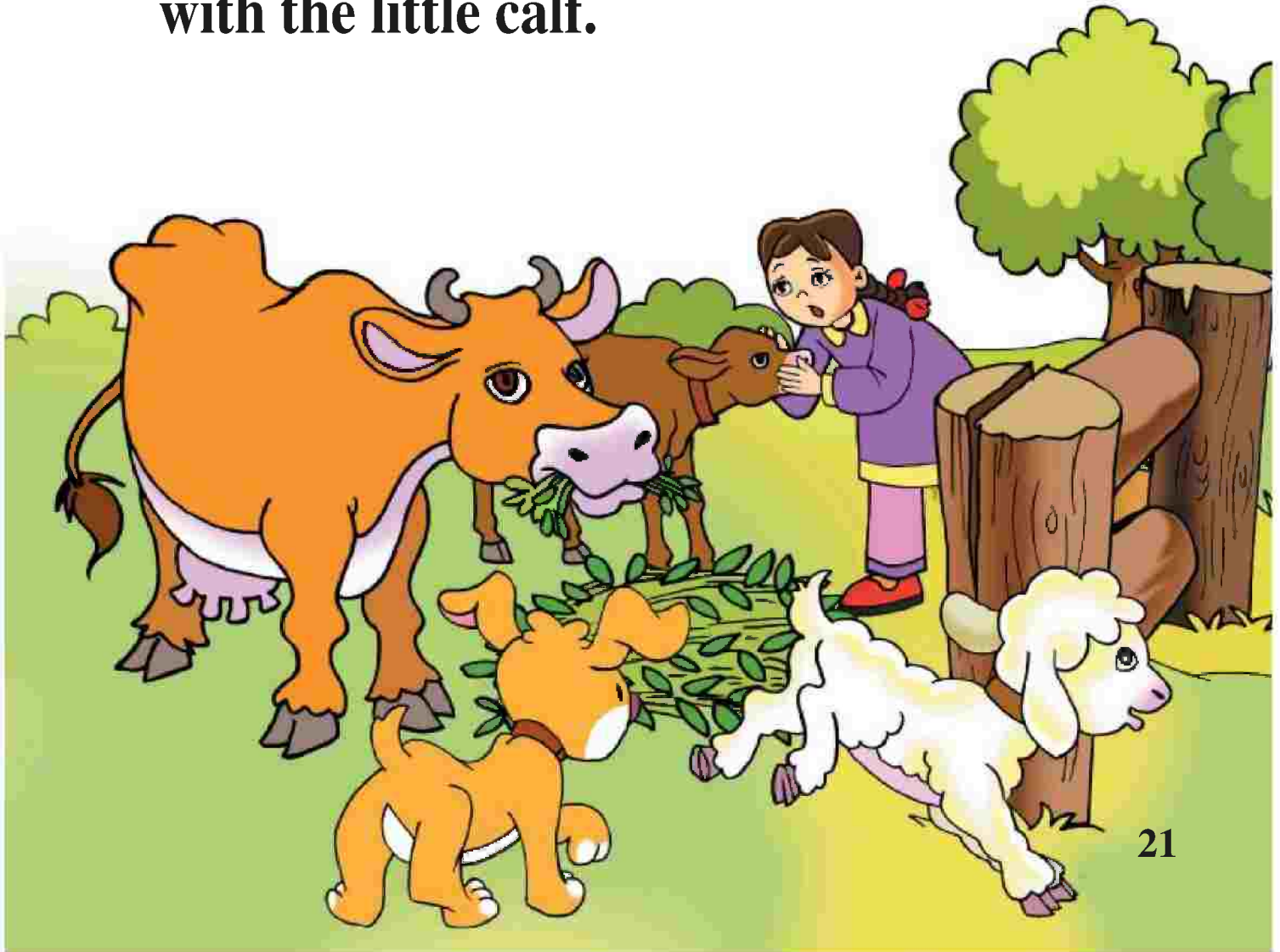

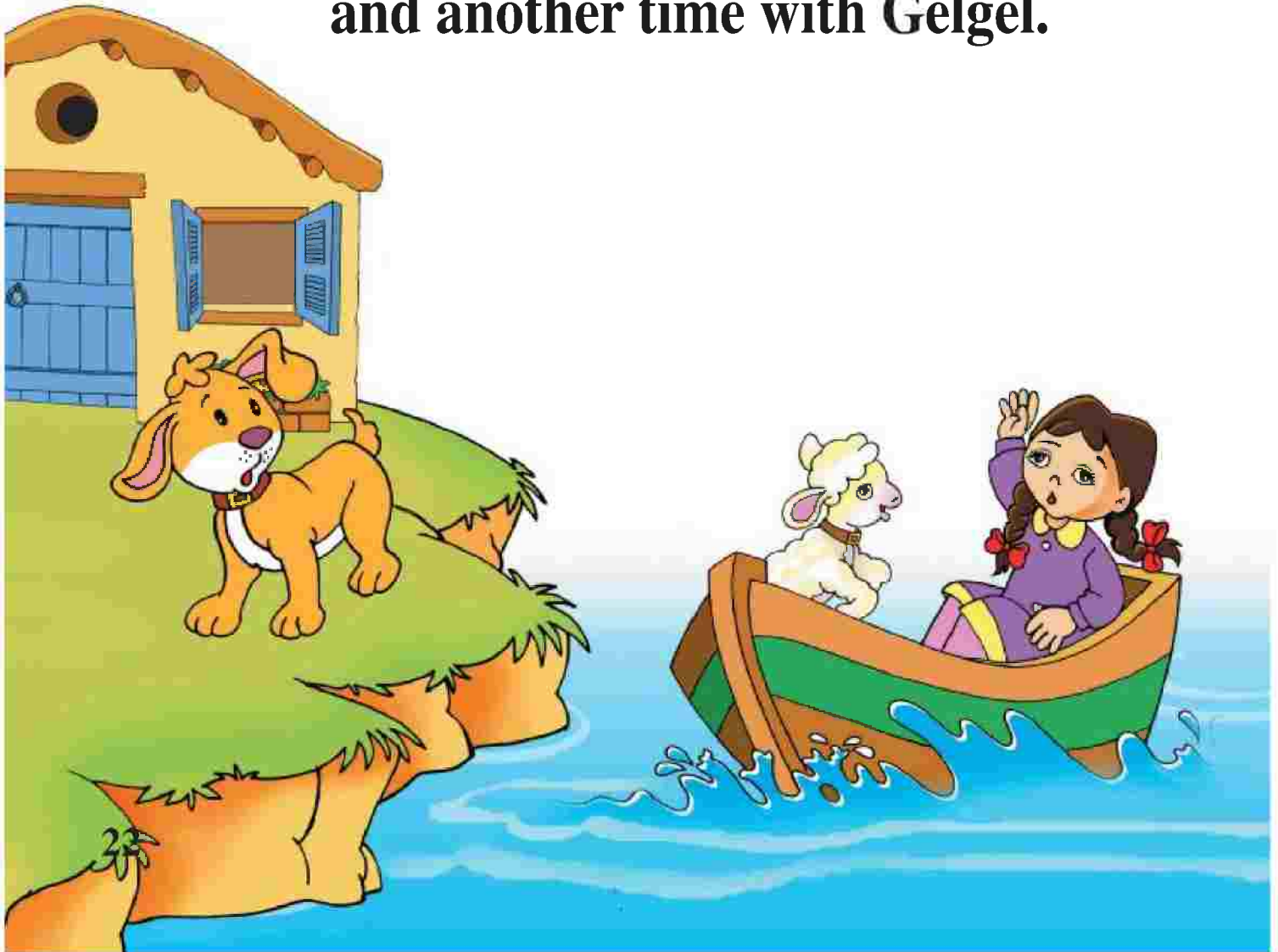
**Once again, she came back to pick
