






**One day, Sameh saw a big

coming train hits it?”




Sameh hurried and called his friends.







**His friends rushed to the rock

rock away.”**






**The friends went to uncle

the rock.**






**Uncle Youssof quickly drove

friends.**






**They all tied the rock with
a big rope.**





They tied the other end to the tractor.
