quaking

qualms

have qualms

quandary

quantum

a quantum jump

e.g. The election of a female president is a quantum leap forward for sexual equality.

quart

get/put a quart into a pint pot

be in Queer street عليك ديون لعدة أشخاص

e.g. Now don't you go doing anything that'll land you in Queer street!

a question mark over sth

e.g. Neither company has performed well over the last year and there's a question mark over their long term survival.

e.g. The recent spate of government scandals has left a question mark over their ability to govern.

be out of question

e.g. A trip to New Zealand is out of question this year.

beg the question يشير التساؤل

e.g. It's all very well talking about extra staff but it rather begs the question of how we're going to pay for them.

call sth into question

e.g. The report's findings call into question the safety and effectiveness of all such drugs.

e.g. So we were having dinner in this Italian restaurant and that's when he popped the question.

a quick one كأس سريع من المشروبات الروحية

e.g. Have you got time for a quick one before you go?

a quick study سريع فى الاستذكار

e.g. He's a quick study and easily grasps all the details of a discussion.

as quick as a flash/wink

e.g. As quick as a flash, he snatched the book and ran out of the room.

call it quits
