**Each to his/her own**

e.g. I find it hard to believe that anyone enjoys gardening. Ah well, each to his own.

**eager**

**an eager beaver**

e.g. Who's the eager beaver who came in at the weekend to finish this work off?

**eagle**

**watch sb/sth with an eagle eye**

**watch sb/sth with eagle eyes**

تراقب بعين كعنين النسر

e.g. The teacher was watching the children with an eagle eye, making sure they behaved themselves.

**an eagle eye** عين قوية وفاحصه كالنسر

e.g. Nothing escapes his eagle eye.

**eagle eyed (adj.)** صفة

**ear**

**be out on your ear** تُطرد من العمل

e.g. You'll be out on your ear if you don't start doing some work around here.

**can do sth on their ear** تقوم بالعمل بسهولة

e.g. Ask Jane to make it, she can bake a cake on her ear.

**grin/smile from ear to ear**

تبدو سعيداً للغاية (يبتسم من الأذن للأذن)

e.g. "We've had a fantastic response," he said grinning from ear to ear.

**play it by ear**

يرتجل - يتصرف حسب الظروف وليس بتخطيط مسبق

e.g. I'm not sure how long I'll stay at the party. I'll just play it by ear.

**bend sb's ear** تطيل الكلام فتجلب اللمل للمستمع

e.g. Don't let her bend your ear about how over. Worked she is.

**have sb's ear**

e.g. He's a powerful industrialist who has the president's ear.

**have an ear for sth**

e.g. She's never had much of an ear for languages.

e.g. George knew of the proposal already; he always has his ear to the ground.

**in at one ear and out at the other**

e.g. Every-thing we teach the boy goes in at one ear and out at the other.

**all ears** كله آذان صاغية - يستمع بإصغاء تام

e.g. When he said that he had exciting news, they were all ears.

**box a person's ears** يلطم - يصفع

e.g. If you don't go to bed, I'll box your ears.

**come to (or reach) one's ears** يبلغ مسامعه

e.g. If the news should come to the old man's ears, it would break his heart.

**fall on deaf ears** يلتقي آذاناً صماء - يقابل بالإهمال

e.g. My complaints have fallen on deaf ears and nothing changed.

**give one's ears** يضحى بأى شخص (لتحقيق أمنية)

e.g. I'd give my ears to visit Venice this spring.

**prick up one's ears** يرهف السمع

e.g. I heard you talking about dinner; so I pricked up my ears because I'm hungry too.

**Wet behind the ears** تعوزه الخبرة والمعرفة

e.g. They took no notice of anything I said: they clearly thought I was still wet behind the ears.

**earful**

e.g. You can just imagine the earful he gave her when they got home.

**early**

**an early bath**

e.g. The spokesman took an early bath after a series of embarrassing and incorrect statements.

**an early bird** من يستيقظ مبكراً

e.g. Ellen's the early bird in this house, not me.

**the early bird catches the worm**

اللى سبق أكل النبق (ع.م.)

e.g. If you see a job that interests you, apply as soon as possible. The early bird catches the worm.

**It's early days (yet)** الحكم الآن سابق لأوانه - هناك متسع من الوقت

e.g. Both teams are near the bottom of the league, but it's early days yet.

**ears**

**(sb's) ears are flapping** هناك من يسترق السمع

e.g. I can't talk now, Ears are flapping.

**his/your ears must be burning**

هناك من يتكلم عنه وراء ظهره أى فى غيابه

e.g. All that talk about William, his ears must have been burning.

**about/around sb's ears**

مشروع يفشل ويقضى على آمال شخص ما

e.g. His business folded and collapsed about his ears.

**can't believe your ears** لا تصدق ما تسمع

e.g. She couldn't believe her ears when they told her Jim had been arrested.

**have nothing between the/your ears**

e.g. He's very good-looking but has absolutely nothing between the ears, I'm afraid.

**pin back your ears**

**go to earth**

**be as easy as falling off a log**

**be as easy as pie** يكون سهلاً جداً

e.g. Oh, come on! Even a child could do that, it's as easy as pie.

**be easy meat - be an easy mark**

e.g. Go easy on the boy, he didn't know he was doing anything wrong.

**it's easy to be wise after the event**

**it's easy to be smart after the fact**

**the ebb and flow** العجز والمد - الهبوط والصعود

e.g. The government did nothing about the recession, hoping it was just part of the ebb and flow of the economy.

**echo**

**cheer sb to the echo** (تعبير قديم)  
يهتف لشخص هتافاً قوياً

e.g. The team captain was cheered to the echo when he was presented with the cup

**eclipse**

**be in eclipse** (تعبير أدبي)  
في حالة من الركود بعد نجاح

e.g. His career was in eclipse until he made a comeback in this surprise hit film.

**economical**

**be economical with the truth** (مزاح)  
مقتصد في الصدق (لا يذكر الحقيقة كلها) فيما  
يقول أو يفعل

e.g. He was economical with the truth - he gave here a censored account of what was discussed.

**edge**

**be on edge** في حالة توتر عصبي

e.g. The players were all a little on edge before the big game.

**have the edge on/over sb/sth**

يفوق بمقدار ضئيل

e.g. He's got the edge over other teachers because he's so much more experienced.

**keep sb on the edge of their seat**

**keep sb on the edge of their chair**

e.g. You must rent this video, It keeps you on the edge of your seat right up to the end.

**live on the edge** تحيا حياة مملوءة بالمخاطر

**from around/at the edges**

e.g. This songwriting partnership began to fray at the edges after both partners got married.

**educated**

**an educated guess** تخمين مبني على

حقائق علمية - تخمين أقرب إلى الصواب

e.g. Scientists can do no more than make educated guesses about future climate changes.

**effing**

**effing and blinding**

يسبب ويلعن (في حالة الغضب)

e.g. I could hear Bill effing and blinding as he tried to repair the washing machine.

**egg**

**can't boil an egg** لا يعرف كيف يطبخ

e.g. Don't expect a dinner invitation from Laura - she can't boil an egg.

**have egg on your face**

تبدو غيبياً نتيجة لما فعلت

e.g. You'll be the one who has egg on your face if it goes wrong.

**lay an egg** يفشل في إمتاع أو لفت اهتمام الناس

e.g. Our first two sketches got big laughs, but the next two laid an egg.

**eggs****put all your eggs in one basket**

e.g. The police are very much behind the eight ball - they've had no more leads on these burglaries.

**elbow****elbow grease**

lay/place an embargo on

e.g. The new taxes will lay an embargo on the company's future prosperity.

### embark

embark on يشرع في

e.g. She embarked on her scheme as soon as she was well enough to get up.

### embarrassment

an embarrassment of riches

وفرة من الثروة تحريك في الاختيار بينها

e.g. This club has an embarrassment of riches. All their players are good, so who do they pick for their side?

### éminence grise

شخص له سطوة ونفوذ ولكن بلا مركز رسمي

e.g. Although he never became a minister, he

was the party's éminence grise for 15 years.

### empty

empty nest syndrome حالة شبه مرضية تنتاب

الآباء عندما يرحل الأبناء عن البيت

e.g. The last of her children had recently moved out and she was suffering from empty nest syndrome.

empty vessels make (the) most noise/sound

من قلت حكمته كثر كلامه - علا صوته

e.g. David talks as if he's an expert on everything, but empty vessels make most noise.

e.g. We had flowers, the speeches, the presents. the whole enchilada.

e.g. After his wife died, he was so depressed he decided to end it all.

e.g. Education should be an end in itself.

the end justifies the means الغاية تبرر الوسيلة

e.g. Unfortunately, we'll have to cut down the forest to make space for the golf course, but I feel the end justifies the means.

at the end of the day أهم ما في الموضوع

e.g. At the end of the day, what matters is that you're safe.

be at the end of your rope تكون في حالة

see the error of your ways

e.g. It's the story of a corrupt policeman who finally sees the error of his ways.

esprit de corps روح الفريق

e.g. Companies that involve their employees in planning have the best esprit de corps.

essence

e.g. For successful military strategy, secrecy is of the essence.

et al

et al ومن يتبعهم

e.g. This issue is discussed in more detail in the article by Cooper et al.

even

even stevens - even steven متساوين تقريباً

e.g. Give me £20 and we're even stevens.

I'm not worried about a few pence.

break even لا ربح ولا خسارة أى المسألة متعادلة

e.g. After a bad year in 1968 the company just broke even in 1969.

e.g. get an even break - give sb an even break

تعطى شخصاً الفرصة لتحسين وضعه

e.g. Until now no one had given her an even break to prove what she could do.

e.g. He swore he'd get even with Lee for humiliating him.

**turn king's/Queen's evidence**

e.g. She was given a lenient sentence in exchange for turning king's evidence.

**evil**

**give sb the evil eye** عين ملؤها الغضب -

e.g. I arrived late for the meeting and Steve Thomson gave me the evil eye.

**extra**

e.g. He's a nice guy, always ready to go the extra mile for his friends.

**extracurricular activity** خارج العرف فيما

e.g. You're looking very tired these days Ron!

**keep your eye on the ball**

e.g. You have to keep your eye on the ball in business.

**take your eye off the ball**

(بالعكس) تفغل عن الموضوع

e.g. If you're a manager you can't afford to take your eye off the ball for one minute.

**keep your/an eye on sth/sb**

أحرص - تعهد برعاية شخص أو شيء

e.g. 1. Could you keep an eye on the baby for me a while?

e.g. 2. I kept an eye on him all the time as I felt sure he was about to do something stupid.

**keep an eye out for sb/sth** تراقب قدوم

e.g. Keep an eye out for the signposts for Yosemite.

**look sb in the eye/eyes**

ينظر في عيني شخص آخر بلا خوف أو خجل - يواجهه

e.g. I felt so embarrassed. I just couldn't

look him in the eye.

**see eye to eye** الاتفاق في وجهات النظر -

يلتقيان في وجهات النظر

e.g. We see eye to eye on most important issues.

**there is more to sth/sb than meets the eye**

الموضوع ليس بهذه البساطة هناك ما وراءه

e.g. There's more to this than meets the eye. I suspect Tom's not telling the truth.

**with an eye to sth**

بغرض آخر - بقصد - بقية كذا

e.g. With an eye to the upcoming election the President had hired a new speechwriter.

**eyeball**

**eye ball to eyeball** بطريقة مباشرة

(العين في العين) (ع.م.) بالمواجهة

e.g. Troops on the ground are likely to remain eyeball to eyeball for a while yet.

## eyebrows

## raise (a few) eyebrows

يُدْهِش - يَصْدَم الإحساس

e.g. Anna's miniskirt raised eyebrows at the board meeting.

## eyeful

ملء العين

get an eyeful (عامية) يرى بوضوح

e.g. Ed got an eyeful on the beach when a woman took her top off right in front him.

## eyes

sb's eyes are bigger than their belly/  
stomach

تمتلئ معدته ولا تشبع عيناه (عينه فارغة ع. م.)

e.g. I can't finish this piece of cake. I'm afraid my eyes were bigger than my stomach as usual.

## sb's eyes are out on stalks

## sb's eyes are popping out of their head

يحملق في (من الدهشة)

e.g. You should have seen Pete when Bec turned up in her short skirt. His eyes were out on stalks.

## all eyes are on sb/sth

كل العيون على شيء ما أو شخص ما في انتظار ما سيجد من الأمور

e.g. All eyes are on the Prime Minister to see how he will respond to the challenge to his leadership.

## be all eyes

e.g. We were all eyes as the prince and princess emerged from the palace.

## can't take/keep your eyes off sb/sth

## close your eyes and think of England

e.g. You can't just shut your eyes to your problems and hope that they'll go away.

## open your eyes to sth

e.g. He's finally opened his eyes to what has been going on behind his back.

## sb could do sth with their eyes

e.g. I've driven along this route so often, I could do it with my eyes shut.

## couldn't believe your eyes

يصعب عليك تصديق ما ترى لفرابته

e.g. She couldn't believe her eyes when she saw the new house. It was so grand.

## cry your eyes out

## have eyes in the back of your head

e.g. Parents of young children have to have eyes in the back of your heads.

## have eyes like a hawk

**lay/set eyes on sb/st - clap eyes on**

**e.g.** I've loved him ever since I first set eyes on him.

I wish I'd never clapped eyes on that money.

**make eyes at sb** يرمق بنظرة غرامية، يشاغل بالنظرات - يبصص (ع.م.)

**e.g.** Sally spent the whole evening making eyes for you.

**only have eyes for sb**

**e.g.** You've no need to be jealous. I only have eyes for you.

**open sb's eyes to sth**

**e.g.** Having children of my own opened my eyes to the hurt I had caused my parents.

**an-eye-opener**

**with your eyes open**

**e.g.** I found Seorge up to the eyebrows in business.

**in one's mind's eye** بعين خياله

**e.g.** In my mind's eye I can still see my old home.

**do in the eye** يفتش - يخدع

**e.g.** The people selling clothes in the market will do you in the eye if you are not very careful.
