e.g. What I object to is being spoken to as if I am a complete idiot.

occur to (sb.)

occurs, occurring, occurred
occur to

يَدُورُ فِي خُلْدِي. يَدُورُ بِخَاطِرِهِ.

e.g. It didn't occur to me that he might be offended.

offend against (sth.) (تَغْيِيرُ رَسْمِيٍّ)

offends, offending, offended
offend against

بِإِسْبَاءِ إِلَى. يُسَبِّبُ الْإِسْتِيَاءَ أَوْ خَدَشَ الْمُتَشَاعِرَ.

e.g. The channel was banned on the grounds that it offended against taste and decency.

offer up (sth.) or offer (sth.) up

offers, offering, offered
offer up

بَقَدَّمَ (الْقَرَابِينَ). يُؤَدِّي (صَلَاةَ الشُّكْرِ) بِقَدَمِ آتَاتِ (الْتَّنَاءِ) لِرَبِّهِ.

e.g. Prayers of thanksgiving were offered up each morning.

oil over

بِدَهْنٍ. يُغَطِّي بِطَبَقَةٍ مِنَ الزَّيْتِ.

e.g. He oiled the tools over and put them away in the shed.

ooze + particle

(١) يَنْزِ بَرْسُوحٍ.

e.g. The oil began to ooze out through the tiny hole.

(٢) (حَمَاسَتُهُ) فَتَرَّتْ، حَبَّتْ، حَمَدَتْ.

e.g. His enthusiasm slowly began to ooze away in the face of their hostility.

open into (sth.)

opens, opening, opened

open into

حُجْرَةٌ أَوْ بَابٌ يُفْتَحُ عَلَى حُجْرَةٍ أُخْرَى أَوْ مَكَانٍ آخَرَ.

e.g. Their bedroom opens into the bathroom.

open off (sth.)

حُجْرَةٌ أَوْ مَنطَقَةٌ تُدْخَلُ فِيهَا مِنْ خِلَالِ حُجْرَةٍ أَوْ مَنطَقَةٍ أُخْرَى.

e.g. The square opens off the main street of the town.

open onto

تَافِذَةٌ أَوْ حُجْرَةٌ تُطِلُّ عَلَى مَكَانٍ.

e.g. The windows at the back open onto fields.

open out (sth.) or open (sth.) out

(١) تَفْتَحُ الْغِلَافَ عَنِ السَّيِّءِ. يَفْتَحُ (عُلْبَهُ) خَرِيْطَةً.

e.g. He opened the map out and studied it carefully.

(٢) تَفْتَحُ الْفُرْصَةَ لِأَنْصَحَامِ أَعْضَاءِ جُودٍ: أَيْ تُفْسِحُ الْمَجَالَ.

e.g. The debate should be opened out into a general discussion on environmental policy.

open out

(الطَّرِيقَ) يَتَّسِعُ.

e.g. As you emerge from the wood the path opens out into a wide track.

open up (sth.) or open (sth.) up

(١) تَفْتَحُ بَابَ مَبْنًى.

e.g. We've arranged for the caretaker to open up the building.

(٢) (دَوْلَةٌ) تَسْمَحُ بِالْأَنْوَاتِحِ وَتَسَهِّلُ الْأَجَارَ مَعَهَا.

e.g. Eastern European markets are opening up to western investment.

(٣) تَخْلُقُ فُرْصًا جَيِّدَةً.

e.g. When you've got a qualification like that, so many career opportunities open up.

(٤) تَبْدَأُ وَيَبْشُرُ (عَمَلًا جَارِيًا).

e.g. Fast food restaurants are opening up everywhere you look.

open up (sth.) or open (sth.) up

(١) نَظَهَرَ سُنَيْنًا كَأَنَّ مَخْبَأًا أَوْ مَخْذِبًا.

e.g. Getting to know Patrick opened up a whole new world for me.

(٢) يَزِيدُ مِنْ يَقَاطِ الْقَوْرِ.

e.g. Latest surveys show the labour party opening up a clear lead in the opinion polls.

open up

(١) يَبُوحُ بِمَا فِي نَفْسِهِ. يُمَضِّضُ.

e.g. I've never opened up to anyone like I do to you.

(٢) يُطْلِقُ النَّيْرَانَ.

e.g. Enemy guns opened up as the planes flew in.

open up (sb./ sth.) or open (sb./ sth.) up

يَفْتَحُ جِسْمَ إِنْسَانٍ أَوْ حَيَوَانَ بِقَصْدِ إِجْرَاءِ جِرَاحَةٍ طَبِّئَةٍ.

e.g. When the doctors opened her up they couldn't find anything wrong with her.

opt in/ into

تَخْتَارُ الْأَنْضَمَامَ إِلَى (الْمَتَشْرُوعِ).

e.g. I've decided to opt into the company's pension scheme.

e.g. He's decided to opt out of the company's pension scheme.

opt out

تَقَرَّرَ الْخُرُوجَ مِنَ (الْمَتَشْرُوعِ).

e.g. Many schools have decided to opt out of government control and become independent.

order (sb.) about/ around

orders, ordering, ordered

order about/ around

يَأْمُرُ بِعُطْيِ تَعْلِيمَاتِ (الشَّخْصِ مَا).

e.g. You can't just come in here and start ordering people about.

order in (sth.) or order (sth.) in

تَطْلُبُ وَجَبَاتِ غِدَائِيَّةٍ لِتَأْتِيكَ بِالْمَتْرَلِ.

e.g. We stayed in last night, watched a video and ordered in a pizza.

order out

تَطْلُبُ أَكْلًا مِنَ الْخَارِجِ بِأَنْيِكَ فِي الْبَيْتِ أَوْ مَكَانِ عَمَلِكَ.

e.g. We ordered out for sandwiches and worked through lunch.

own up

owns, owning, owned

يَقْرُرُ بِعَتْرَفِ بِ-

e.g. Someone obviously broke the machine but no one will own up to it.
