**vamps, vamping, vamped**  
**vamp up**

يَجْمَلُ بِلَفَقٍ (فِصَّةٍ مَثَلًا).

e.g. It's basically the same musical but they've vamped it up with some new songs.  
 e.g. He vamped up some ugly stories about them.

**vamped it up**

e.g. After work I just veg out in front of the television.

**venture forth** (اسْتَفْتَمَالَ رَسْمِيًّا)  
**ventures, venturing, ventured**  
**venture forth**

تَتْرِكُ الْمَنْزِلَ أَوْ مَكَانًا آمِنًا إِلَى مَكَانٍ آخَرَ.

e.g. Once the rain stops, I thought we might venture forth.

**venture on/ upon (sth.)** (اسْتَفْتَمَالَ رَسْمِيًّا)

نَحَاطِرُ بِالتَّحَرُّكِ. تَقُومُ بِعَمَلٍ شَيْءٍ صَغْبٍ أَوْ خَطِرٍ.  
 e.g. The men ventured forth to meet the new danger.

**verge on/ upon (sth.)**  
**verges, verging, verged**  
**verge on/ upon**

تَصْرَفُ أَوْ تُشْعُورُ بِقَارِبِ. يُشَابِهُ. يَفْتَرِبُ مِنْ.

e.g. This action verges upon aggression.  
 e.g. I'm afraid his behavior verges on madness.

**vest (sth.) in (sb.)** (تَغْيِيرُ رَسْمِيٍّ)  
**vests, vesting, vested**

**vest in**

(الشَّخْصُ) يُخَوِّلُ سُلْطَةَ. يُعْهَدُ إِلَيْهِ بِعَمَلٍ رَسْمِيٍّ.  
 e.g. Real political power is vested in the presidency not in the cabinet as claimed.

**vie for**  
**vies, vying, vied**

**vie for**

يَتَنَافَسُ لِيُحْطِئَ بِشَيْءٍ.

e.g. More than 30 different military groups are vying for power and control of the region.

**view with (sb./ sth.)**

**view with**

يَتَنَافَسُ مَعَ شَخْصٍ أَوْ شَيْءٍ.

e.g. Sports activities vie with music for time in the school day.

e.g. City firms vied with each other to hire the brightest young staff.

**visit (sth.) on/ upon (sb./ sth.)** (تَغْيِيرُ رَسْمِيٍّ)

**visits, visiting, visited**

**visit on/ upon**

تُسَبَّبُ ضَرَرًا بِالْعَمَلِ لِشَخْصٍ أَوْ لِمَكَانٍ. تُهْلِكُ. تُدْمِرُ.

e.g. Death & destruction are daily visited on civilians caught in the war.

**visit with (sb.)**

(أ) تَتَكَلَّمُ مَعَ صَدِيقٍ.

e.g. I hope there'll time to visit with you both if I stop by tomorrow.

(أ) قَضَى اللَّيْلَ فِي مَنْزِلِ صَدِيقٍ مَثَلًا.

e.g. My parents are visiting with us this weekend.

vote down (sth.) or vote (sth.) down  
votes, voting, voted

vote down

يُسْقِطُ (الْمُرْتَبِح) بِالتَّصْوِيتِ ضِدَّهُ. تُصَوِّتُ ضِدَّ  
الْمُتَشَرِّعِ.

e.g. The people have voted him down

e.g. Parliament voted down the proposal.

vote in

(الشَّعْبُ) يُصَوِّتُ مِنْ أَجْلِ. يُدَلِّي بِصَوْنِهِ لِصَلْحَةِ  
(شَخْص).

e.g. The people have voted in a new government.

e.g. They voted in a new president.

vote out

الْمَجْلِسُ يُسْقِطُ الْحُكُومَةَ بِالتَّصْوِيتِ ضِدَّهَا.

e.g. The people have voted out the old government.

vote through

(الْجَمْعِيَّةُ) تُجِيزُ نَقْرَ تَوَافِقِ عَلى (الْمُتَشَرِّعِ).

e.g. The assembly has voted through the new reforms.

vouch for (sb.)

vouches, vouching, vouched

vouch for

بِشُهَدَائِهِ (تَرَاهُ) شَخْصَ مَا. يَضْمَنُ (تَرَاهُ)  
شَخْصَ مَا.

e.g. I can vouch for his integrity.

vouch for (sth.)

تَضْمَنُ بِمَا لَكَ مِنْ خِبْرَةِ جَوْدَةِ شَيْءٍ مَا (عَمَلِ أَبِي)  
مَثَلًا.

e.g. I can give you a copy of the report but I can't vouch for its accuracy.
