

Idioms

العبارة الاصطلاحية هي مجموعة كلمات ذات معنى خاص مختلف عن معنى كلماتها منفصلة.

The verb Be has a different meaning when it is followed by a preposition (or an adverbial particle)

يختلف معنى فعل Be عندما يتبعه حروف جر (أو أداة ظرفية)

Be away: be at a distance; be on a journey يتغيب

- He will be away from home for a month

Be back: be home again; return from an absence يعود

- Is the manger back yet?
- I'm back from my journey

Be out:

(1) Not to be at home (at the office, etc)

يكون بعيدًا عن المنزل أو المكتب

- The manager is out just now.

(2) Not at present in the library

- The book is out. (= The book had been borrowed from the library by someone)

(3) **No Burning:** لا يحترق

- The fire is out

(4) **Discovered; known** يكتشف - يعرف

- The secret is out

(5) **Published** (كتاب) ينشر

- His new book is out

Be in:

(1) be at home (at the office, etc)

يكون في المنزل (المكتب)

- Is your brother in?

(2) Arrived يصل

- Is the train in?

Be over: finished, completed *ينتهي - ينتهي*

- The storm is not yet over

Be all over: completely finished

- The fighting is all over

Be all over with somebody = ruined: dying

يلم به الخراب – يُشرف على الموت

- It's all over with him (He's ruined, or he is sure to die soon, etc)

Be on:

(1) Fastened or attached on *مثبت*

- Your hat is not on straight

(2) Covering or forming part of a surface *مغطي*

- Is the cloth on (= spread on the table)

(3) In action; in use; flowing; running *مستخدم - دائر*

- The lights were all full on (giving their full light)

(4) Happening *يحدث*

- What is on? What is happening?
- There is a nice film on *معروض* at Cinema metro

Be up: (1) at the top, in superior position *مرتفع*

- Is the flag up or down?
- No longer in bed *مستيقظ*
- I was up at six O'clock

Be up to:

(1) Occupied or busy with *مشغول - منهمك بـ*

- What's he up to?

(2) Equal to; capable of *كُفء أو أهل لـ*

- He's not up to his work (not good enough for the work)

Some verbs change in meaning when we put short words (prepositions) after them.

تتغير معاني بعض الأفعال عندما نضع بعدها حروف جر

Put: place, lay يضع

- He put the book on the table

Put on: clothe with يرتدي

- He put on his coat and left the house

Take: get or lay hold of يأخذ

- He took the books and left
- Who took my umbrella?

Take off = remove يرفع

- It was very hot, so I took off my coat

Look: use one's sight; try to see ينظر

- We looked, but saw nothing

Look at: بفحص الشيء بعناية ينظر إلى..

- Come and look at my photograph album

Look for: search for, try to find يبحث عن

- I am looking for my pen. I lost it this morning

Look after: take care of, watch over يعتني بـ

- Will you look after the children for me, please?

Knock: hit, strike يقرع - يضرب

- He knocked (struck by accident) his head on the wall

Knock at: يطرق

- Someone is knocking at the door

Knock (off): strike off يرتطم بـ

- I knocked the vase off the table and broke it

Knock off: (1) stop work; finish work يتوقف عن العمل

- He always knocks off the price

(2) deduct; reduce the price

يخصم - ينقص (من قيمة فاتورة)

- The shop – assistant knocked 10 % off the bill

Knocked over يقلب – يصدم ويوقع

- A car knocked the boy over
- He knocked the table over while he was running

Knock out: hit so hard as to make helpless or unconscious

يهزم بضربة قاضية

- The boxer knocked out his opponent خصمه

Phrases with set

Set off = set out = start one's = journey يبدأ رحلة

- They have set off on a journey round the world
- They set out early in the morning

Set up:

(1) **Get** (somebody) started or established يزوده برأس المال

- His father set him up as a bookseller
(i.e. provide the capital زوده بالمال)

(2) **Start** (a house, a business) يشيد

- He set up a house and lived in it.

(3) **Create:** يسجل - يوجد

- He set up a new world record عالميًا قياسيًا in swimming

(4) **Cause:** يحدث

- I wonder what has set up this irritation التهاب in my throat

(5) **Restore after illness:** يعيد إليه الصحة

- Her holiday in the country has set her up again

(6) **Develop the body by physical training**

يبني الجسم بالتمرين الرياضي

- He has a well set up figure

Phrases with drive

(1) operate, direct the course of (a motor – car, vehicle,
يقود (عربة)

- He drives his car very carefully.

(2) cause (animals, people) to move in some direction by using cries, blows, etc. يسوق حيواناً – يدفع شخصاً

- The merchant drove the cattle to market

- Our army drove the enemy out of their positions

- Our army drove the enemy back

(3) (of mind, water) send, throw (lifeless things) in some direction

- The ship was driven on to the rocks

(4) (of steam, electricity,) be the power to operate (الآلة) أدار
The machinery s driven by steam

(5) cause somebody to be in a certain state; compel somebody to do something. يدفع - يجبر - يرغم

- You'll drive me mad

- He was driven by hunger to steal

Different meaning of put

Put: move so as to be in a certain place يضع

- He put the book on the table

Put away: put in the usual place of storage يضعه في مكانه المألوف

- He read the book, then he put it away

Put down:

(1) set or place down يضع

- Put down that gun, please!

(2) write down; make a note of يكتب

- Here's my address – put it down before you forget it

Put off: postpone يؤجل

- He was ill and had to put off the meeting

Put on: clothe with يلبس

- He put on his coat as it was very cold

Put out: extinguish; cause to stop burning يطفى

- The firemen soon put the fire out

Put up:

(1) build; erect يبني - يشيد

- They put up their tent in the desert

(2) provide food and lodging يقدم الطعام والمأوى

- We can put you up for the week-end

Put up with: bear patiently يتحمل

- We cannot put up with the means of transport any longer

Different meaning of call

Call at: go to (a house, an office, etc) يزور أو يذهب إلى مكان

- I called at Mr. Green's house

Call on: pay a person a short visit يزور شخصاً

- I called on Mr. Green

Call out: cry or shout to attract attention ينادي

- He called out to me but I did not hear him

Call off: cancel يلغي

- It began to rain so we called off the match

Call (somebody) up: telephone (him) يتصل تليفونياً

- I'll call you up this evening

Make - do

Make conversation: converse; talk with يحادث

- I tried to make conversation

Make the beds: put the bedclothes in order ready for use

يعد الفراش

- When she made the beds she went downstairs

Make a noise: produce a noise يحدث ضوضاء

- You mustn't make so much noise.

Make a promise: to promise يعد – يعطي وعداً

- I made a promise not to see him again

Make trouble: cause trouble يسبب متاعب

- He's the sort of person who always makes trouble

Make a difference: be of importance يميز

- Do you think it will make any difference

Make progress: advance يتقدم

- He is learning English but he hasn't made much progress

Make money: obtain wealth يثري - يفتني

- He made a lot of money in south America

Make a speech: talk to or address the public

- I was asked to make a speech يلقي خطاباً

Make a mistake: be wrong يخطئ

- I'll never make the mistake again

Do:

Exert, use يبذل

- He always does his best

Work at; be busy with

- When did you do your homework.

Do a favour: show kindness يصنع معروفاً

- Do me a favour, please

Clean, sweep, brush, etc ينظف (المنزل)

- I did a few jobs about the house

Perform carry out ينجز – يؤدي

- I can't do any more work today

Deal with; attend to *ينكب على*

- I want you to do exercise 24 on page 16

Do shopping; go to shops to buy things. *يتسوق*

- I did a lot of shopping yesterday

Do business: *يؤدي عملاً تجاريًا*

- That shop does very good business

Phrases with pick

Pick up: take hold of and lift (*يلتقط (عن الأرض)*)

- He picked up a long pipe

Pick (somebody) up: take (somebody) a long with one

يأخذ معه كراكب

- I shall pick you up in the car this evening

Pick up: learn; acquire *يكتسب - يتعلم*

- I picked up a lot of English while I was in England

Pick out: choose *يختار*

- There are so many beautiful cards on display, I can't pick out the ones I like best

Phrases with at

Indicating order (in time) *ترتيب زمني*

- At first *أولاً* Adam and his men were able to take photographs
- After walking several hours, we arrived at the village at last. *أخيرًا*

At once: immediately; without delay *حالا*

- He at once ordered his men to throw out two food sacks

Indicating the place in which something or somebody was, is or will be.

تدل على مكان

- Ahmed is not at home. He's at school

At present: now الآن

- We don't need any more at present

At any rate: in an case: whatever happens على أية حال

- It's a pity you can't come to the concert
- At any rate you'll be able to hear it on the radio

At heart: in one's inmost feelings في أعماق النفس. في الواقع

- I know he's often rude to people, but he's a very pleasant person at heart.

At least على الأقل

- I didn't know you wouldn't be coming
- At least you could have telephoned me

At times: occasionally; now and then. أحياناً – من حين لآخر

- He behaves very strangely at times

(be) At a loss: be perplexed, uncertain. مرتبك - متحير

- I don't know what I can do about it
- I'm completely at a loss

To have: as a principal verb فعل رئيسي **has several meanings**

To hold: يمسك I have a stick in my hand

To own or posses: يملك – يمتلك Have you any money?

To own certain abilities: كفاءات Om Kalthoum had a beautiful voice

To receive: يتلقى **to get, to take:** You need to have a rest

أنت محتاج أن تأخذ راحة

To experience: يتعرض لـ يلاقي She had a pleasant time

To suffer: يعاني من Yesterday I had a headache

To allow: يسمح Nabil won't have noise while he is reading

To cause somebody to do something:

- Please have the boy bring my newspapers
- She will have my shoes cleaned for me

- He had his hair cut yesterday

To cause something to be done:

- They had (= got) the house painted before they sold it
- I shall have (= get) my book printed.
- I didn't have (= get) my watch repaired

To be forced to مضطر – مجبر

- I have to (= am obliged to مضطر) do this but I have not yet done it
- She has to leave now

Had rather يفضل – من الأفضل

على الرغم من أن الاصطلاح rather had يحتوي على الفعل had الذي هو صيغة الماضي إلا أن معناه يدل على الحاضر ويشير إلى الزمن الحالي لا إلى الزمن الماضي.

- I had rather stay than go away

Had better الأحسن – يحسن

على الرغم من أن الاصطلاح better had يحتوي على الفعل had الذي هو صيغة الماضي إلا أن معناه يدل على الحاضر، ويشير إلى الزمن الحالي لا إلى الزمن الماضي.

- You had better do what I tell you

Must have لابد أن يكون قد

- The road is wet مبلل it must have rained

Phrases with say

Say – tell

Say:

- 1- Utter ينطق
 - Did you say anything?
- 2- Recite يتلو
 - He knelt down and said his prayers.
- 3- Ask; order يطلب

- If you want some more cake, please say so?
- 4- **Recommend; praise** يوصي - يمدح
 - It would help if you could say a good word for him.
- 5- **Suppose** يفترض
 - You can learn English in, let us say, two years.
- 6- **Speak** يقول
 - What did you say?
- 7- **Express** يعبر
 - Say what you think?

Note لا تتبع بـ "say" is not followed by لاحظ

Tell

Tell: if someone tells you something, they give you information, usually in words. يخبر

- Six Swedish hostages have been told they can leave the country tonight.
- 1- **Inform of; express** يخبر - يعبر عن
 - Can you tell me anything about it?
- 2- **Relate** يحكي
 - Please tell us a story.
- 3- **Tell lies** يكذب
 - He often tell lies, I don't believe him.
- 4- **Order; to give order** يأمر
 - Tell him to wait for a while.
- 5- **Have an effect** يحدث أثرًا
 - Every word that he said told on his hearers.
 - His hard life told on him, and he suffered in health.
- 6- **With can, could, be able:** know, distinguish, judge يحكم

- Can you tell the time in English?
 - 7- **Tell the truth** يقول الصدق - الحقيقة
- I respected him because he told the truth.
 - 8- **Tell a joke** يروي نكتة - ينكت
- He is fond of telling jokes.
 - 9- **I can tell you = I assure you** أؤكد لك
- It was a very fine game. I can tell you.
 - 10- **Tell = count** يعد - يحصي
- He sat in the corner telling his beads. السبحة
 - 11- **Tell one from another = know which = tell the difference** يفرق
- These two brothers are very alike; you can hardly tell one from the other.
- Tell off = blame** يوبخ - يلوم (only in speech)
- The master told Ahmed off for his bad behaviour

Phrases with on

- On display: exhibited** معروضة
- There was a great deal of machinery on display
- On show: displayed; exhibited** معروضة
- The most wonderful piece of machinery on show was a steam hammer
- On business:** for the purpose of doing business. في مهمة
- He has gone to London on business
- On foot:** walking سيراً على الأقدام
- I didn't catch the bus. I came here on foot
- On duty:** engaged in one's regular work مُنْهَك في أداء عمله
- I asked to see the officer on duty الذي في الخدمة
- On the whole:** taking everything into consideration عموماً - ككل
- On the whole:** it has been a very successful year

On fire: burning يحترق

- Look at that smoke. That building must be on fire

On purpose: by invention, not by chance عمدًا

- I don't think it was an accident. He did it on purpose

On the average: on a standard or level regarded as ordinary or usual

في المتوسط

On the average: I make six telephone calls a day

On any account: in any case بأي حال من الأحوال

- You mustn't on my account sign the contract توقع على العقد before you read it.

On second thoughts: after further thinking. بعد تفكير أكثر

- I know I had agreed to let you go to the cinema, but on second thoughts, you should stay at home and finish your homework.

Phrases with Give

Give:

- (1) Cause somebody to possess, have or get something (without payment). يعطي
 - I gave him the book.
 - I gave the book to him.
- (2) Cause somebody to have something in exchange for something else. يعطي مقابل
 - How much will you give me for my old car?
 - I would give anything to know what happened?
- (3) Of non - material things: للأشياء الغير مادية:
 - His visit gave me much pleasure.
 - The thief was given six years' imprisonment.

(4) Supply or produce: يمد

- The sun gives us light and warmth.
- He gave a cry of joy.

Give back: (something or somebody) back: restore, send back: يعيد

- The teacher read the notebook and gave it back to the pupil

Give in:

(1) Hand in (something) to the proper person; deliver. يسلم

- Please give in your examination paper now.

(2) Yield, surrender: يستسلم

- The enemy soldiers were forced to give in.

Give (something) away: give freely: distribute:

يهب.. يوزع الهدايا

- He has given away all his money

Give up:

(1) Stop (doing something) عن يقلع عن

- He gave up smoking

(2) Surrender; deliver (somebody) to يستسلم

- The escaped prisoner gave himself up
- They gave the thief up to the police

Phrases with how

How

- Here are question phrases with how

How often? كم عدد المرات؟

- How often does he come to Cairo?

How soon? كم سريعًا؟

- How soon can you come?

How late? كم متأخرًا؟

- How late did you come in last night?

How far? كم يبعد؟

- How far is Tanta from Cairo?

How long? كم من الوقت؟

- How long are you staying in Egypt?

How long ago? كم مضى من الوقت؟

- How long ago did this king live?

How old? ما العمر؟

- How old is your father?

How much? ما السعر؟ كم الكمية؟

- How much is a kilo of meat?
- How much sugar do you like in your tea?

How many? كم عدد؟

- How many pupils are absent today?

How about? ما رأيك أو قولك في؟

- How about going for a walk?

Phrases with get

Get = buy يشتري

- Wait here till I get اشترى tickets
- She went to the butcher's to get some meat

Get = obtain يحصل على

- I must get احصل على an answer before I leave
- He got a good job in a modern company

Get = receive يستلم - يتلقى - ينال

- Did you get my letter (message - postcard) yesterday?
- I got the first prize

لاحظ أن فعل get بمعنى يستلم أو يتلقى لا يُستخدم في المبني للمجهول

Get = hear يسمع

- He was speaking in a low voice and I couldn't get what he said
- Speak up. I can't get اسمع what you're saying
- I couldn't get (hear) what he said on the phone

Get = bring يحضر - يجلب - يوصل

- A taxi will get us home in time
- Please, get me a cup of coffee
- The train will get you there by 7.00

Get = prepare يعد - يجهز

- Wait till I get breakfast immediately
- I'm getting (preparing) lunch

Get = become يصبح

- My dog is getting old
- Cheer up افرح: don't get depressed
- It is getting dark

Get: go to; arrive with some difficult (بشيء من العناء) يصل

- We got home very late

Get = fetch يذهب ليأتي بشيء

- Will you get me my bag from my office?

Get = catch an illness يصاب بمرض

- He got a rare disease when he was in Greece

Get = understand يفهم

- He didn't get what I mean

Get = annoy يضايق -- ينال من

- His stupid remarks ملاحظات really get me

Get = hit يُصيب - يخطئ

- The driver was drunk كان سكران and got (hit) three stationary cars

- One of the stones got him in the eye

“Get” as a phrasal verb

Get at: يبلغ - يدرك - يصل

- She put the sweets on a high shelf where the children couldn't get at them

Get away ينطلق - ينصرف - يفر

- He was caught by the police, but he managed to get away

Get back يسترد - يعود - يرجع

- He has gone to Cairo, but he hopes to get back tomorrow

Get down يترجل - ينزل

- He had climbed on top of the cupboard, but when someone took the chair away he couldn't get down

Get in (into) يدخل

- He stopped the car and invited his friend to get in
- He managed to get in the train before it moved

Get into يلتحق بـ - يدخل

- I hope you'll get into the university

Get into يرتدي ملابس

- He has grown so much that he can hardly get into his clothes

Get off يخرج من - ينزل لينجو من عقاب

- Get off the bus at the next stop
- The two boys got off with only warning but the judge sent the man to prison

Get on يتقدم - ينجح

- You'll have to work hard if you want to get on

Get out يخرج

- As the car would not go, she decided to get out and walk

- They got out of the house at six

Get over يتغلب على – يتعافى – يُشفى من

- Has he got over his illness yet?
- He got over his illness

Get up ينهض من الفراش – ينتصب واقفاً

- I never get up in the morning very early
- I usually get up at 6:30

Get to يصل إلى

- We got to the airport in time

Get through ينجح في – يجتاز

- He got through all the exams

Get rid of يتخلص من

- Try to get rid of your bad habits
- How can I get rid of the flies الذباب in the kitchen?

Idioms: meaning “Getting angry”

- My sister blew her top when I asked her to lend me her camera = My sister became extremely angry quickly or suddenly.

غضبت غضباً شديداً فجأة

- The teacher flew into a rage when Samir slept during the lesson = The teacher suddenly became extremely angry.

استشاط غضباً – غضب غضباً شديداً

- My mother gave me a piece of her mind when I forgot to post the letter = My mother told me how angry she was with me when I forgot to post the letter.
- My father hit the roof when my sister didn't prepare dinner while my mother was away = My father became extremely angry when my sister did not prepare dinner while mother was away. غضب غضباً شديداً.

- Don't get so steamed-up about this matter, it is not really important = Don't get so angry and worried about this matter , it is not really important. غاضب وقلق
- The people were up in arms about imposing new taxes = The people were very angry and ready to argue or fight. ثائرون بشدة على – محتجون بشدة على.

Some uses of will

- 1) To express a future prediction تنبؤ عن المستقبل
 - Our team will beat your team
- 2) To talk about a future fact حقيقة مستقبلية
 - I'll be fifteen next year
- 3) To make a quick decision لاتخاذ قرار سريع
 - **Father:** would you like an orange juice or an apple juice?
Mostafa: I'll have an apple juice, please, dad.
- 4) To offer to do something عرض لعمل شيء
 - I'll cook dinner tonight
- 5) To make arrangements عمل ترتيبات
 - I'll see you on Friday
- 6) To make a threat للتهديد
 - I'll tell your parents if you do that again

Words used as verbs & nouns أسماء أفعال تستخدم

- (1) **Book** (كتاب) يحجز
 - We booked a room at the hotel
 - I read a very interesting book
- (2) **Force** - قوة - يجبر
 - The thief forced the people to give him money
 - The air force had done the first strike
- (3) **Form** (شكل - استمارة) يكون

- The students formed a queue
- You must fill in the form to get a passport
- (4) **Break** فسحة - يكسر
 - We have a break for 15 minutes
 - Be careful or you will break the glass
- (5) **Order** يأمر - ترتيب - أمر
 - Do as I tell you. That's an order
 - He ordered me to fetch the books
- (6) **Ring** خاتم - دبلة - يتصل تليفونيا
 - Ring me tonight at 8:15. I think you have my telephone number
 - I bought my fiancé a beautiful ring on the occasion of our engagement
- (7) **Rest** يستريح - راحة - باقي
 - I work without having a rest
 - You must have a rest or you will suffer
- (8) **School** سرب - جماعة - مدرسة
 - I saw a school of fish while diving in the sea
 - A school is a place where we learn
- (9) **Light** يشعل - ضوء - خفيف
 - He asked for a light for his cigarette
 - The sun gives us light
 - The bag was light, so Eman could carry it
- (10) **Queue** يقف في طابور - طابور
 - We queued up to go into the cinema
 - There was a long queue outside the cinema
- (11) **Rush** يندفع - اندفاع
 - The policeman rushed the robbers into the police car
 - There is a traffic jam in the rush hour

- (12) **Act** عمل - أو يعمل يتصرف
– He acted wisely when he confessed اعترف that he was wrong
– It is a brave act to confess your misbehaviour
- (13) **Wonder** عجب - يتعجب
– I wonder why Ali is absent all this week
– I looked at the pyramids in wonder
- (14) **Disguise** التتكر - يتتكر
– The boy disguised himself as a girl
– I did not recognize him because he was in disguise
- (15) **Harm** أذى - يؤذي
– Has the rain harmed the flowers?
– There is no harm in swimming here
- (16) **Lie** أكذوبة - يكذب
– You lied to me yesterday
– You should not tell a lie.
- (17) **Shock** (ذهول) صدمة - يذهل
– I was shocked when I heard of his death
– His death was a great shock to me
- (18) **Race** سباق - يسرع
– Laila raced to the door to open it
– Mostafa came first in the 100 metres race.
- (19) **Grin** ابتسامة - يبتسم
– When he heard the good news, he grinned
– Her face wore اكتسى a pleasant grin when she met me
- (20) **Smile** ابتسامة - يبتسم
– He was smiling at us in a friendly way
– Fatma had a big smile on her face
- (21) **Yell** صيحة - يصيح
– He yelled (out) orders. Don't yell at me

- He gave a yell of pleasure when he saw me
- (22) **Heat** حرارة - يسخن
 - We'll heat some milk for the tea.
 - The heat of the body makes the bed warm
- (23) **Cover** يغطي غطاء
 - The thief covered his face with his hand
 - I always put a cover on the chair to keep it clean
- (24) **Smell** يشم - رائحة فريسة
 - Some animals can smell their prey فريسة as far as 16 kilometres away
 - Some animals have an amazing sense of smell
- (25) **Stay** يقيم - إقامة
 - Please come and stay with us for a few days
 - She enjoyed her stay with her sister
- (26) **Talk** يتحدث - حديث
 - They talked over their plans for the day
 - Their talk was about their plans for the day
- (27) **Start** يبدأ - بداية
 - The friends started removing the rocks
 - We started out early in the morning.
 - We made a start at 6 o'clock
- (28) **Worry** يقلق - القلق
 - Don't worry. There can't be anyone there now
 - My father's illness is a worry to me
- (29) **Lead** يقود - رصاص
 - A blind cannot lead a blind
 - Lead is a heavy metal used to make pipes
- (30) **Centre** يتركز - مركز
 - Centre this picture on the wall, please.
 - Although London is Britain's capital, it is not at the centre

- of the country
- (31) **Line** بصطف - صف
 - Lovely parks and trees line many of the city's streets
 - There is a line of trees on both sides of the street
- (32) **Call** يسمي - ينادي - مكالمه
 - Many people call Paris "The City of Light"
 - He gave his wife a telephone call but she was out
- (33) **Rest** يستريح - راحة
 - Let us rest here for a few minutes
 - I must have a rest for a few minutes
- (34) **Bear** يتحمل - يولد - الدب
 - Some animals can bear the scorching heat of the sun.
 - I was born in Cairo.
 - The Polar bear lives in the ice and freezing cold of the North Pole.
- (35) **Signal** يعطي إشارة - إشارة
 - The teacher signalled to the pupil to begin the answer
 - A red light is a signal of danger
- (36) **Pull** يشد (يجذب) جذب - شد
 - The cart was pulled by a horse
 - The pull of gravity keeps our feet on the ground
- (37) **Use** يستخدم - فائدة - استخدام
 - We use a knife for cutting meat
 - Plastic has many useful uses
- (38) **Park** يركن سيارة - موقف - منتزه
 - Park your car here
 - Leave your car in the hotel car park
 - The children were playing in the park
- (39) **Water** ماء - يروي - يدمع - يسيل لعابه
 - This is fresh drinking water

- I've been watering the garden since 5 o'clock

Applicant: a person who applies for a job

Speech

Benefit (v): يفيد غيره The trade agreement will benefit our country

Benefit (from - by) يستفيد من

- You should benefit from reading such useful books

Likely (adv.): probably من المحتمل

- I'd very likes have done the same thing in your situation
- Search all the most likely places first may be he's hiding in the cellar

Likely (adj.): something that is likely, will probably happen or is probably true, probable محتمل الحدوث

- Heavy rain is likely in the next 24 hours
- What kind of change is likely?

Fan: a piece of eclectic equipment with revolving blades which keeps a room or machine cool. مروحة

- She uses an extractor fan in the kitchen to get rid of the smell of cooking

Fan (v): يهوى

- If you fan yourself, you wave a fan or other flat object in order to move the air and make yourself cooler.
- She took some sheets of paper and fanned herself with them.

Fan: someone who likes a particular sport or who admirer a famous person, a football fan: – etc (معجب (بمطرب – بفنان – لاعب كرة)

- The singer's fans are so fascinated by his new album
