





كَانَتَا تَجْمَعَانِهِ مِنْ حُبُوبِ الْقَمْحِ.




Over a branch of a huge tree, there were two friends of pigeons live in a small nest. They put all their wheat in the nest.


One of them went away for some weeks and left her friend, and when she returned she found that the wheat became little, and thought that her friend deceived her and ate from it.


The pigeon was angry and said to her friend: "We had agreed not to eat from the wheat, but you deceived me, and ate from it while I was away."

وَضَعَتَاهَا فِي الْعُشِّ، وَلَمَّا اشْتَدَّتْ حَرَارَةُ الصَّيْفِ، جَفَّتِ الْحُبُوبُ، وَقَلَّ حَجْمُهَا.



The pigeon swore to her friend that she didn't eat from the wheat and that the seeds were wet when we put it in the nest, and when the summer came, the seeds became dry and little.

وَكَبِرَتْ كَمَا كَانَتْ أَوَّلَ مَرَّةٍ.



After few months, The winter came, and the rain fall over the seeds, then the wheat returned to its first volume.
