

The big box was very dark inside so little Miss Piece of paper, Tin can, Glass bottle and Plastic cup held hands tightly.






The box was then emptied into a wide waste ground and a large magnet pulled Tin can and her metal friends.



The magnet threw all its load in a powerful compressor that changed Tin can and her friends to a single piece of metal. The piece of metal was then taken to a melting factory.




A worker took Miss Bottle and her other glass friends to a glass furnace to be melted. Mr. Plastic cup and his friends were taken by another worker to the plastic factory.

newspapers and magazines.**




**Suddenly, the piece

She was quite scared and surprised at what was going on around her while an iron-made arm was strongly mixing the papers together.




Little Miss Piece of paper was transformed along with the others into a soft piece of pastry that was stretched by another machine to become a long roll of paper.




Miss Piece of paper looked at her face and found that it was shiny white. She was very delighted and she started to sing joyfully.






Then little Miss
