AMERICAN ENGLISH SPELLINGS

American (U.S.) English spellings must be used in all IIIT publications. A list of some of the most common words spelled differently than in British English is given below. For definitive rulings on U.S. spellings, refer to the Webster dictionary:

benefit, benefiting, benefited

color, coloring, colored
cooperate/cooperation
defense (noun), defenseless
dialog/dialogue
epilog/epilogue
favor, favorable, favoring, favored
flavor, flavored
fulfill, fulfilling, fulfilled
gray (**not** grey)
honor, honorable, honoring, honored

jail (**not** gaol)
judgment
labeled
level, leveling, leveled
marvelous
meager
meter, centimeter, kilometer etc.

practice (verb and noun), practicing

signaled
skeptical
skillful, skillfully, skillfulness
succor
unraveled
valor
worship, worshiping, worshiped, worshiper

N.B. Many words that may end in either -ize or -ise in British English should be written with -ize.
