

SUMMARY

The book is devoted to the Soviet-Egyptian relations between 1958 and 1964. Development of these relations was determined by objective reasons and also by personal relations between Nikita Khrushchev and Gamal Abdel Nasser, leaders of the Soviet Union and Egypt. The book includes documents and stories about meetings of two leaders in the Soviet Union, the United States and Egypt, exchange of letters between them, memories of Nikita Khrushchev, abstracts on Egyptian-Soviet relations from the books by Mohamed Heikal who was the closed ally of Nasser.
