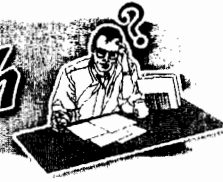


The Paragraph



A paragraph is a series of sentences that develop **one idea**. In U.S. academic prose, that idea is usually stated in a general form in one sentence, called the topic sentence. That sentence tells your audience what to expect in the paragraph. The rest of the sentences in the paragraph provide the reader with specific explanation or proof (evidence, support) of the general topic sentence. The supporting sentences help the reader understand more clearly what the writer means; they show that the topic sentence is valid.

Of course, a reader does not have to agree with your topic sentence. But if your paragraph is complete, the information should show the reader that your point of view is worth while and clear.

Your paragraph will be clear and enjoyable to read if you follow these directions:

First : remember to indent the paragraph – once only!

Second : remember that the paragraph should be neither too short nor too long; make it approximately eight to twelve sentences in length.

Third : and most important, organize and develop your paragraph carefully. Remember that the paragraph should contain one central idea only, that it should have unity, coherence, continuity and adequate development. If you follow these directions, your paragraph should be as good as or better than any other model paragraph.

His childhood in Gamaleya has greatly influenced his writings.

By writing the "Trilogy", he won popularity and world-wide fame. He wrote a large number of interesting and realistic novels such as the "Beginning and the End". The Thief and the Dogs.

In 1988 he was awarded the Noble Prize for literature in recognition of his works. He died in 2006.
