e.g. Six months later he fell off the wagon in spectacular fashion with a three-day drinking spree.

e.g. He wisely decided to hitch his wagon to the environmentalist movement, which was then gaining support throughout the country.

waifs and strays

e.g. Emma was always bringing home waifs and strays and giving them a bed for the night.

waiting

be waiting in the wings

البديل، من ينتظر أن يُستدعى ليحل محل شخص آخر
e.g. The rumour is that Green will be sacked and Brinkworth is waiting in the wings to take over as manager.

play a/the waiting game يؤخر تصرفاته

e.g. Those investors who are willing to play the waiting game may find it to their advantage.

wake-up

a wake-up call

e.g. The 1971 earthquake was a wake-up call to strengthen the city's bridges.

walk

a walk of life مهنة الإنسان في الحياة أو

مركزه الاجتماعى - من كل الطبقات أو المهن
e.g. There were people at the meeting from almost every walk of life.

walking

give sb their walking papers

يطرد شخصاً من العمل
e.g. The manager gave his old secretary her walking papers and hired his daughter to do the job.

get your walking papers

e.g. Since they got their walking papers from the chemical company none of them has been able to find another job.

wall

be off the wall

يكون مختلفاً عن غيره من الأشخاص أو الأشياء
e.g. Even at school he was considered off the wall by most of the students.

off-the-wall على غير العادة

e.g. She's got a really off-the-wall sense of humour.

drive sb up the wall

تسبب لشخص الغضب أو الملل

e.g. I was being driven up the wall by their silly chatter.

e.g. Working in a factory would have driven me up the wall.

go to the wall (مشروع) يفشل

e.g. After nine months of massive losses the company finally went to the wall.

hit a/the brick wall

nail sb to the wall

read/see the handwriting on the wall

started to behave better.

e.g. Those who failed to read the writing on the wall lost a lot of money.

e.g. Why don't we go and talk about this somewhere quieter? Walls have ears, you know.

wall-to-wall

e.g. independent channels are promising wall-to-wall coverage of the Olympics.

wandering

wandering hands

e.g. Joe was notorious for having wandering hands and all the women tried to avoid going into his office.

want

for want of a better word

e.g. They have problems, which for want of a better word, we call psychological.

How much do you want to bet?

هل تستطيع الرهان؟ هل أنت مستعد للرهان؟ كناية عن أنك لا تعتقد في صحة ما يقول.

Do you want a/to bet?

e.g. "I don't think she'd be stupid enough to lend him any money." "How much do you want to bet?"

e.g. The war of words between the two rivals for the presidency continues to

dominate the bulletins.

warpath

be on the warpath

يبحث عن أشخاص ليصب غضبه عليهم (فكاهي)

e.g. Look out, the boss is on the warpath again.

wars

have been in the wars (طفل) قد جرح أو

أصابه أذى، وكأنه كان في معركة (تعبير فكاهي)

e.g. You poor little boy, you have been in the wars.

warts

warts and all

تفضح عيوب شخص، يصور شخصاً دون إخفاء عيوبه

e.g. He tried to portray the president as he was warts and all.

warts-and-all

e.g. The book is a warts-and-all portrait of the socialist movement.

wash

come out in the wash

كله حيطلع في الغسيل (ع.م)، سوف يظهر الحق

e.g. They don't want the police to investigate, but they're afraid of what might come out in the wash.

it'll all come out in the wash

سوف تنتهي الأمور على خير

e.g. It was the wrong thing to say, but don't get too upset, I'm sure it'll all come out in the wash eventually.

will nor wash لا يثبت أو لا يصمد

(للمنطق) - لن يتقبل الناس (الموضوع)

e.g. That story about missing the last bus won't wash with me, young lady!

waste

be a waste of space (عن شخص) تعتقد أنه

لا لزوم له أي لا ينفع، كماله عدد (ع.م)

e.g. Her husband's a complete waste of space.

watched

A watched pot never boils ما أصعب

الانتظار - اترك الأشياء دون انتظار

e.g. There's no point sitting by the phone waiting for it to ring. A watched pot never boils.

watching

be like watching grass grow شيء مُمل

e.g. To watch somebody fly-fishing is like watching grass grow.

be like watching paint dry

be as interesting as watching paint dry

شيء ممل للغاية (تعبير فكاهي)

e.g. To me watching golf on television is about as interesting as watching paint dry.

water

be (like) water off a duck's back

شيء لا قيمة له ولا تأثير

e.g. He's always being told he's lazy and incompetent, but it's just water off a duck's back to him.

be water under the bridge

be water over the dam

موقف سيء انتهى منذ مدة طويلة ولا أثر له في النفوس

e.g. We certainly had our disagreements in the past, but that's all water under the bridge now.

blow sth/sb out of the water

يبدد أو يهزم شيئاً أو شخصاً نهائياً

e.g. They came to court with fresh evidence that would, they said, blow the prosecution's case completely out of the water.

not hold water

لا يستقيم منطقياً، لا يثبت للاختبار

e.g. Most of the arguments put forward by our opponents simply do not hold water.

opposite

e.g. If his theory holds water, it could be a break through in cancer research.

test the water/waters

e.g. Perhaps you should go to a couple of meetings to test the waters before you decide whether to join the club.

tread water

e.g. I'm just treading water until I get an opportunity to try for a job with more responsibility.

e.g. It was a mistake to try and cover the waterfront in her talk. One or two points would have been enough.

e.g. It's obvious one salesman can't cover the waterfront, we'll need a whole team for this area.

waterloo**meet your waterloo**

e.g. She finally met her waterloo when she tried to take on the club champion.

waters**muddy the waters**

waterworks**turn on the waterworks**

e.g. He always turns the waterworks if he doesn't get exactly what he wants.

wave**catch the wave**

ينضم إلى موضة شائعة

بفرض الكسب ، يواكب الموضة

e.g. Older Spanish restaurants are expanding to try to catch the tapas wave.

ride (on) a/the wave

يركب الموجة، يشارك في الآراء والأنشطة الرائجة والسائدة

e.g. She came to power riding on a wave of personal popularity.

wavelength**be on the same wavelength**

شخصان على نفس الموجة أى متفاهمان

e.g. To my surprise, I found that we were absolutely on the same wavelength about most of the important issues.

waves**make waves**

يعكر الصفو، يخلق المتاعب، يسبب هزة

e.g. Some workers felt it was not the time to make waves by organizing a union.

e.g. Their influence waxes and wanes depending on which party is in power .

way**all the way**

على طول الخط، تتفق أو تختلف بأقصى ما يمكن

e.g. If you want to complain to the boss, I'll support you all the way.

along the way

في خلال المدة

e.g. I've been in this job for thirty years and I've picked up a good deal of expertise along the way.

(in) any way, shape or form

بأية طريقة

e.g. I've never been involved in any way, shape, or form with criminal activities.

be out of sb's way

يبعد عن طريق شخص

ما ، خارج نطاق طريق شخص ما

e.g. Are you sure you don't mind taking me home Ted? It's a bit out of your way.

be out of the way (مكان) خارج نطاق
المدن أو القرى، بعيد عن العمار (ع)

e.g. It's a lovely village but it's a little out of the way.

out-of-the-way

e.g. We hired a car and spent a few days visiting some out-of-the-way places.

claw your way back from sth

بعد موقف صعب تسترد مكانك السابق بجهد كبير

e.g. They clawed their way back from almost certain defeat to win by a single point.

couldn't (act/argue/fight) your way out of a paper bag

e.g. It's no good asking Jim to protect you. He couldn't fight his way out of a paper bag.

go all the way تكمل ما بدأت عمله

e.g. I wouldn't go all the way with a boy if I didn't love him. ١. في حالة العملية الجنسية

e.g. We finally decided to go all the way and redecorate the entire house.

e.g. Do you think she can go all the way at Wimbledon this year?

e.g. I had no home, no money, and I didn't

know which way to turn.

open the way for/to sth يفتح المجال لـ

e.g. Removing customs controls could open the way to an increase in drug smuggling.

pave the way for sth يمهد الطريق إلى

e.g. Scientists hope that data from this expedition will pave the way for a more detailed exploration of Mars.

pay your way تدفع ثمن كل شيء تستعمله

e.g. We've always paid our own way and never taken a penny from the state.

pay its ways (عن آلة) ما تكسبه من جراء

استعمالها يفوق الثمن الذي دفعته فيها

e.g. Our new combine harvester should be paying its way by next year.

point the way يبين ما يمكن عمله في الوقت

الحاضر أو المستقبل - يبين الطريق

e.g. Their recent work on developing an AIDS vaccine points the way forward.

see which way the cat jumps

البطء في اتخاذ القرار حتى تتضح الأمور

e.g. We'd better wait and see which way the cat jumps before we commit ourselves.

see your way (clear) to doing sth

تكون قادراً وموافقاً على عمل ما

e.g. Do you think you could see your way clear to lending me a bit more money?

smooth the way for sb./sth

يسهل لشخص الأمور ، يمهد الطريق

smooth sb's/sths way

e.g. Parents can do a lot to smooth the way for their children when they start school

that's the way the cookie crumbles

ما قدّر يكون

e.g. I can't believe they chose Sam for the job and not me. Ah well that's the way the

cookie crumbles.

wing your/its way

يسافر أو يطير بسرعة ، يسافر على جناح السرعة

e.g. Within a few hours the package will be winging its way across the Atlantic.

way-out شيء مبتكر، جديد وغريب

e.g. He produced some really way-out designs for the opera house.

ways

ways and means

وسائل وطرق للحصول على شيء

e.g. Surely, there are ways and means of achieving our objectives which don't involve spending quite so much money.

change/mend your ways يغير من تصرفاته

e.g. If he wants to carry on living here, he's going to have to change his ways.

cut both/two ways سلاح ذو حدين

e.g. Censorship cuts both ways; it prevents people from being corrupted, but it often also prevents them from knowing what is really going on.

wayside

fall by the wayside

١. يفشل في تكملة عمل بدأه - يفقد الطريق

e.g. A lot of students fall by the wayside during their first year at university.

٢. شيء يتوقف الناس عن عمله أو استعماله

e.g. Many new drugs fall by the wayside in the laboratory.

weak

weak at the knees

يشعر بالضعف من جراء خوف أو انفعال

e.g. The very thought of jumping out of an aircraft with a parachute made him go weak at the knees.

a weak link (in the chain) أضعف نقطة في

نظام أو أضعف فرد في مجموعة قد يتسبب في فشلها

e.g. It's a strong team, though the goalkeeper may be a weak link because he's rather inexperienced.

have a weak spot for sb/sth

تشعر بالحب أو بعاطفة نحو شخص أو شيء

e.g. Sarah has a weak spot for basketball players.

wear

wear and tear الاستعمال والاستهلاك

e.g. She made everyone wear slippers inside the house to avoid wear and tear on the carpet.

wear the trousers

من يتحمل المسؤولية الكبرى في علاقة (أي الرجل في علاقة الزواج) (تعبير فكاهي)

e.g. I don't think there's any doubt about who wears the trousers in their house.

weasel

weasel words كلمات تستعمل للتهرب من الإجابة على أسئلة أو لخداع شخص

e.g. She was too experienced an interviewer to be taken in by the weasel words of crafty politicians.

weather

be/feel under the weather تكون مريضاً

e.g. I'm feeling a little under the weather.

I think I may have caught a cold.

keep a weather eye on sth/sb

يراقب شيئاً أو شخصاً تحسباً لقيام مشاكل

e.g. I'd like you to keep a weather eye on the situation and report any major developments to me at once.

wedding

your wedding tackle أعضاء الرجل الجنسية

e.g. He wears special padding to protect his wedding tackle.

wedge

drive a wedge between sb

تدق إسفين (م.ع) تنشر بذور العداء بين اثنين

e.g. This is a clear attempt to drive a wedge between the USA and its western allies.

weigh

weigh your words**weigh each word**

تفكر في الكلمة قبل التفوه بها ، تزن كلامك

e.g. Jake explained the reasons for his decision, weighing each word as he spoke.

weight

be a weight off our shoulders

تتخلص من حمل على عاتقك ، تتخفف من مسؤوليته

e.g. If you could take over the job of organizing the party, that would be a tremendous weight off my shoulders.

carry weight

يمثل قيمة لشخص ويتأثر به - شيء مهم

e.g. Her opinion carries a lot of weight with the boss.

pull your weight

تقوم بما يقوم به الآخرون من جهد

e.g. The rest of the team complained that Sarah wasn't pulling her weight.

throw your weight around

تتصرف بفرور وكأنك خير من بقية الناس

e.g. He tries to impress the rest of us by throwing his weight around at committee meetings.

throw your weight behind sth/sb

يؤيد بقوة وبكل ثقة

e.g. If we could persuade the chairman to throw his weight behind the plan, it would have a much better chance of success.

welcome

outstay/overstay your welcome لا تبقى في

مكان لمدة أطول مما ينبغي، لا تتعد مدة الضيافة

e.g. One more cup of tea and then we'll go. We don't want to outstay our welcome.
well

well and truly نهائياً

e.g. Many people remained in their hiding places until they were sure the war was well and truly over.

be well away

١. تندمج في موضوع (وخصوصاً كلامياً)

e.g. They started talking about football and were soon well away.

٢. في حالة سكر

e.g. Annie was dancing on top of the table, so she must have been well away.

٣. تنام

e.g. Her head started to nod and soon she was well away.

be well in

على علاقة طيبة بشخص أو بجماعة

e.g. There won't be any stopping him now. He's in well with the manager of his company.

تكون على علم كامل

e.g. I'm not very well up on Ancient Greek history.

leave well alone**leave well enough alone**

e.g. So long as the machine still does what you want it to, my advice is to leave well alone.

well-heeled

well-heeled غني، تمتلك أموالاً

e.g. You need to be well-heeled to be able to afford to shop there.

well-hung**well-hung**

رجل يتمتع بعضو جنسي كبير (عامية) تعبير سوقى

e.g. A crowd of well-hung men paraded around in their underwear.

well-to-do

غنى

e.g. In Johannesburg's well-to-do suburbs, residents are hiring security guards to protect their homes.

west

go west

e.g. He went west in a plane crash. My watch went west when I accidentally dropped it on a concrete floor.

wet

a wet blanket

شخص نكد أو ثقيل الظل ،

e.g. I don't want to be a wet blanket, but you really must play your music more quietly or you'll disturb the people next door.

a wet dream

e.g. Most boys start getting wet dreams in their early teens.

e.g. This new machine is a computer buff's wet dream.

be all wet

be wet behind the ears

whack

out of whack

e.g. You can use Carol's old bike. The gears are out of whack, but it still goes.

and politicians are blaming an influx of immigrants.

whale

a whale of a (bill/difference/problem etc)

e.g. We ran up a whale of a bill in the restaurant .

a whale of a (job/party/story etc)

e.g. They've done a whale of a job renovating the building.

have a whale of a time

تستمتع بوقتك بشدة

e.g. Did Sam enjoy himself at the party?

He had a whale of a time.

what

(well) what do you know!

عبارة تدل على الدهشة من خبر تسمعه

e.g. And are you getting married? Well, what do you know.

and what have you

وما شابه ذلك

e.g. There were a couple of bags full of old records, magazines and what have you.

what's up?

ماذا يجري؟

e.g. What's up with Tom? He hasn't spoken all morning.

whatever

whatever turns you on

تعبير عن دهشتك لما

يحبه الآخرون من أمور غريبة (تعبير فكاهي)

e.g. So you stuff animals in your spare time? Oh, well, whatever turns you on.

wheat

separate the wheat from the chaff

ينتقى الشمين من الغث

e.g. A preliminary look through the applications will help you to separate the wheat from the chaff.

wheel

be at/behind the wheel

فى مركز القيادة ، ممسك بالدفة ، يدبر الأمور

e.g. I always feel perfectly safe when Richard's at the wheel.

get behind the wheel يقود سيارة

e.g. When Anna gets behind the wheel of a fast car, she's a danger to the public.

a fifth/third wheel يكون فى مكان وهو غير مرغوب فيه أو زائد عن الحاجة

e.g. I don't have a role in the office any more. I feel like a fifth wheel.

reinvent the wheel تقوم بإنتاج منتج تظنه جديداً وهو فى الحقيقة متوفر بالسوق

e.g. Why reinvent the wheel when there are drugs already in the market that are effective.

wheeling

wheeling and dealing كافة المعاملات المعقدة وغير القانونية فى التجارة والسياسة

e.g. It's an article about all the wheeling and dealing that goes on in financial markets.

wheel; and deal يتعامل مع/ينشغل بأموره المعقدة فى التجارة، يُداور ويتاور

e.g. He's the sort of guy that likes to drive fast cars and wheel and deal on the stock exchange.

a wheeler-dealer

e.g. He worked in the property business for a number of years, acquiring a reputation as a formidable wheeler-dealer.

wheels

the wheels are turning تسير الأمور

e.g. By the late 1940s the wheels were turning that would make a manned space flight possible by the end of the next decade.

oil the wheels يسهل الأمور

e.g. An aid programme was established to oil the wheels of economic reform in the

region.

set the wheels in motion

e.g. A phone call to the right person should set the wheels in motion.

e.g. If we're just spinning our wheels, let us know and we'll quit.

if and when

e.g. Let's not go to the supermarket this week. We can just pick up some food as and when we need it.

whip

crack the whip تستعمل نفوذك (بالعقاب والتهديد) لترغم شخصاً على بذل مجهود أكبر

e.g. We were already three months behind schedule so I thought it was time to crack the whip.

have /hold the whip hand

الشخص أو المجموعة التى تسيطر على الموقف

e.g. So long as we rely on them for money, they have the whip hand.

whipping

a whipping boy كبش الفداء ، الضحية

e.g. Television has been the favourite whipping boy of every social reformer in modern America.

whip-round

a whip-round نقود تجمعها مجموعة من الأشخاص لشراء هدية لشخص

e.g. We had a whip-round for Annie's leaving present.

whirlwind

reap the whirlwind

يواجه عاصفة من جراء فعل خاطئ في الماضي

e.g. Having fired some of his best reporters, he's now reaping the whirlwind with rapidly declining newspaper sales.

whisker بفارق بسيط جدا

e.g. He missed the goal by a whisker.

come within a whisker of sth/doing sth

قريباً جداً من

e.g. He came within a whisker of beating the world champion.

whistle

blow the whistle on sb/sth تبليغ المستول

عن تصرف غير مقبول في الخفاء حتى يضع حداً له

e.g. The kids are encouraged to blow the whistle on any of their friends who are using drugs.

a whistle - blower

e.g. Every organization needs a whistle blower, someone who can stand up and say, 'Hey, you can't do that!'

He/She/They can whistle for it

e.g. If they want money, they can whistle for it. They're not getting a penny out of me! wet your whistle (تعبير قديم)

e.g. You must be thirsty after all that work. Would you care to wet your whistle?

a whistle-stop tour زيارة قصيرة لأماكن عديدة

e.g. Coach loads of tourists come for whistle-stop tours of the main European cities.

whistling

be whistling Dixie

يتكلم ليشيع التفاؤل بين الناس

e.g. We're really making money these days and I'm not just whistling Dixie.

be whistling in the dark

يتفائل دون ما يدعو إلى التفاؤل

e.g. She seems pretty sure she'll win the title, but she may just be whistling in the dark.

white

white trash

أسلوب جارح يوصف به البيض غير المتعلمين

e.g. These are the poor white trash that the middle class don't want to know about.

a white elephant

نقمة في ثوب نعمة، شيء غال ضرره أكثر من نفعه

e.g. The town's new leisure centre, recently completed at a cost of ten million pounds, seems likely to prove a white elephant.

a white knight

شخص يُعطى شركة تقوداً حتى لا تُباع إلى شركة أخرى

e.g. Hope is fading that a white knight will appear to stop the takeover bid.

a white lie

كذبة بيضاء

e.g. I don't see the harm in telling the occasional white lie if it spares someone's feelings.

be as white as a sheet شاحب كالموت، باهت

e.g. She was trembling all over and as white as a sheet.

be as white as snow

ناصع البياض

e.g. His hair and beard were as white as snow.

white-bread

white-bread

e.g. It's a movie about middle America-white-bread characters living white-bread lives.

white-collar

white-collar

موظف بمكتب يقوم بعمل عقلي

وليس جسمانياً - مكتبي

e.g. The earnings of women in white-collar jobs are the second highest in Britain.

whiter

whiter than white

إنسان مشهود له بالأمانة وحسن الخلق

e.g. I never was convinced by the whiter than white image of her portrayed in the press.

whizz-kid

a whizz-kid شخص نابغ وناجح

e.g. Hollywood is American society writ
large.

be writ large مفهوم واضح

e.g. Anger was writ large in his face.

written

be written all over sb's face

مكتوب وواضح على وجه (شخص) ، معبر
e.g. Any fool could see you weren't happy.

It was written all over your face.

it's written in the stars إنه القدر

e.g. It was written in the stars that we
should meet and fall in love.

wrong

back the wrong horse تراهن على الحصان

الخاسر، تدعم شخصاً أو شيئاً يخفق في النهاية

e.g. It was only after we'd invested all the
money that we discovered we'd been
backing the wrong horse.

be in the wrong تقوم بخطأ تلام عليه

e.g. I fully accept that I was in the wrong
and I think I ought to apologize.

be on the wrong end of sth

يعاني من خطأ ارتكبه

e.g. Companies that violate this law can
find themselves on the wrong end of big
law suits.

be on the wrong track تقوم بعمل شيء

بطريقة تؤدي إلى الفشل ، لست على طريق الصواب

e.g. I think the government's on the wrong
track with this latest policy.

don't get me wrong

fall into the wrong hands

get on the wrong side of the law

e.g. From last Monday, owners of fighting dogs who fail to control them in public could find themselves on the wrong side of the law.

go down the wrong way
