## jab + particle

بَسَكَ. بَغِرَزْ وَخَاصَّةً بِأَلَّةٍ حَادَّةٍ. يَجِرْ.

e.g. The boy jabbed the stick in.

jabber away (عَامِّيَّة)

jabbers, jabbering, jabbered

jabber away

يَبْرِرُ يَبْرِرِينَ يَتَكَلَّمُ بِغَيْرِ وُضُوحٍ وَبِلَا مَعْنَى.

e.g. They were all jabbering away in Italian and I couldn't understand a word.

jabber out

يَتَمَيِّمُ. يُعَمِّمُ.

e.g. She jabbered out her prayers to finish them as quickly as possible.

jack (sb.) around

jacks, jacking, jacked

jack around

تَسَبَّبَ التَّسَاكِلَ لِشَخْصٍ وَخُصُوصًا بِالتَّحَلِّيِ عَنِ وُعودِكَ مَعَهُ.

e.g. I'm tired of her jacking me around.

jack in (sth.) or jack (sth.) in

تَتَخَلَّى عَنِ وظيفته. تَتْرُكُهَا.

e.g. I've decided to jack in my job and go travelling.

jack off

رَجُلٌ يَجَلِبُ لِتَفْسِيهِ اللَّذَّةَ الجُنَيْبِيَّةَ.

e.g. She found him jacking off over some porn magazines.

jack up (sth.) or jack (sth.) up

(١) يَرْفَعُ حِمْلًا نَقِيلًا (سَيَّارَةً مَثَلًا).

e.g. He jacked up the wheel of the car in order to repair the puncture.

(٢) (عَامِّيَّة) يَرْفَعُ السَّعْرَ أَوِ اليَقِيمَةَ فَجَاءَ.

e.g. Once tourists start visiting a place, the restaurant owners jack up their prices.

jack up (sb.) or jack (sb.) up (عَامِّيَّة)

مُتَعَاظِي المَحَدَّرَاتِ يُحِسُّ بِالتَّشْوَةِ وَالسَّعَادَةِ.

e.g. He was all jacked up on dope.

jack up (تَغْيِيرُ أَسْتِرَالِيَّةٍ) (عَامِّيَّة)

تَرْفُضُ عَمَلِ شَيْءٍ أَوْ تَذْهَبُ لِكَانَ.

e.g. My aunts invited us for dinner. I only hope the kids don't jack up.

be jammed up (always passive)

(١) مَكَانٌ مَسْدُودٌ. مُرْتَجِمٌ (بِالنَّاسِ أَوِ العَرَبَاتِ).

e.g. The entrance to the street was all jammed up with police cars.

(٢) جُزْءٌ مِنْ آلَةٍ يَعْطَلُ عَنِ العَمَلِ. شَيْءٌ يُخَسِّرُ فِيهَا مَثَلًا.

e.g. The paper feeder in the printer is jammed up again.

jar on

jars, jarring, jarred

(١) (الموسيقى أَوِ الصَّوْتِ) بَصَلَتْ السَّمْعَ. يُضَاقِقُ.

e.g. The noise jars on my ears.

(٢) يَزُجُّ. يُبِيرُ الأَعْصَابَ.

e.g. Her constant complaining jars on my nerves.

jaunt about/ around

يَتَنَقَّلُ. يَتَنَزَّهُ. يَتَجَوَّلُ. يَطُوفُ (بِغَيْرِ التَّعَةِ).

e.g. He spends a lot of time jaunting about on the continent.

jaw away

يَبْرِرُ بِبِقِيَقٍ.

e.g. I get tired of him jawing away all the time.

jazz up

jazzes, jazzing, jazzed

jazz up

(١) يَغْرِفُ بِطَرِيقَةِ الجَازِ.

e.g. They have begun jazzing up the classics now.

(أ) **يَجْمَلُ بِتَقْيِشٍ**

e.g. The boys want to jazz up the house, change the décor, have brighter colours.

jerk around (sb.) or jerk (sb.) around

**jerks, jerking, jerked**

jerk around

**يُضَلِّلُ بِخَدَعٍ**

e.g. The public are tired of being jerked around by this government.

jerk around (لَعْفَ سُوْفِيَّة)

**يَتَصَرَّفُ بِطَرِيقَةٍ غِيْبِيَّةٍ أَوْ غَيْرِ لَائِقَةٍ**

e.g. He used to jerk around a lot in class.

jerk off (تَغْيِيرَ مَحْطَوْرٍ)

(أ) **(رَجُلٌ) يُغْطِي لِتَغْيِيسِ بِيْهِ لَدَةَ جَنَسِيَّةٍ**

e.g. He often jerks off in the bath.

(أ) **(لَعْفَ سُوْفِيَّة) يُضَيِّعُ الْوَقْتَ عَبَثًا**

e.g. They're always jerking off and they never get much done.

jib at

**(الْحِصْلان) يَحْنَنُ (الشَّخْصَ) بِحُجْمٍ عَنْ عَمَلِ شَيْءٍ**

e.g. She jibbed at the prospect of working extra hours.

jibe with (sth.) (عَامَّةً)

**jibes, jibbing, jibed**

jibe with

**يَتَّفِقُ أَوْ يَنْسَجِمُ مَعَ. يَتَشَابَهُ مَعَ.**

e.g. Her description of the man didn't jibe with what she told the police earlier.

jockey (sth.) into (sth.)

**jockeys, jockeying, jockeyed**

jockey into

(أ) **(رَاكِبِ سَبَّارَةٍ أَوْ حِصَانٍ) يُلْفُ وَيُدَوِّرُ لِتَحْصُلِ لِنُقْطَةِ الْوُقُوفِ**

e.g. They jockeyed the truck into a space in front of the store.

(أ) **يُكَلِّمُ وَيُرْوِعُ لِتَحْصُلِ عَلَى مَا يُرِيدُ بِتَوْبَرٍ (عَامَّةً)**

e.g. The politicians jockeyed a bout in order to establish relative power within the party.

jog along

**jogs, jogging, jogged**

jog along

(أ) **يَعْدُو بِطُءٍ يَرْكُضُ بِطُءٍ**

e.g. The athletes were jostling along.

(أ) **(مَوْضُوعٌ) يَتَحَرَّكُ بِطُءٍ**

e.g. My research is jogging along quite nicely.

join in

**joins, joining, joined**

join in

**نُسْهِمُ. تَشْتَرِكُ فِي (الْعِبِّ أَوْ حَفَلَاتِ جَمَاعِيَّةٍ مَثَلًا)**

e.g. She watches the other kids playing but she never joins in.

join up

(أ) **يَجْتَمِعُ. يَنْضَمُ إِلَى فِرْقَةٍ فِي الْمَجْتَمَعِ**

e.g. He joined up as soon as he left school.

(أ) **(شَرِكَتَانِ أَوْ مَجْمُوعَتَانِ) يَنْضَمَانِ لِعَمَلِ مَا مَعًا**

e.g. The two design companies are planning to join up and create a new range of foot wear.

join up (sth.) or join (sth.) up

**يُوصَلُ سَبَبَيْنِ بِتَغْيِيسِهِمَا (أَسْلَاكِ مَثَلًا)**

e.g. The electrician joined the wires up.

join with (sb.) (تَغْيِيرَ رَسْمِيٍّ)

**تَنْضَمُ إِلَى مَجْمُوعَةٍ**

e.g. I'm sure everyone will join with me in wishing Chris and Dawn a happy future together.

jolly along (sb.) or jolly (sb.) along

**jollies, jollying, jollied**

jolly along

**يُتَارِحُ. يُسَلِّي. يَبْتَئِ الْحَيَوِيَّةَ وَالْمَرَحَ فِي (شَخْصٍ)**

e.g. I think its one of my jobs as a manager to jolly the staff along.

jot down

**jots, jotting, jotted**

**يَكْتُبُ عَلَى عَجَلٍ. يَدَوِّنُ بِسُرْعَةٍ**

e.g. I always carry a notebook with me so that I can jot down any ideas.

Jostle + particle

**يَتَدَافَعُ. يَتَسَقَّ طَرِيقَةً**

e.g. They jostled through to the exit.

juggle around/about

بَعَثَ بِالأَشْيَاءِ، يُغَيِّرُ نِظَامَهَا. يَتَلَاعَبُ بِالجُدُولِ الرَّمَنِيِّ.

e.g. I wish they would stop juggling the bus times around and settle on a fixed timetable.

juice up (sth.) or juice (sth.) up  
juices, juicing, juiced

juice up

يَجْمَلُ أَوْ يُحَسِّنُ آدَاءَ (سَجَارَةِ مَثَلًا).

e.g. You can always juice up a story by adding some sexy dialogue

e.g. He's going to juice up the car's engine and go racing in it.

jumble up (sth.) or jumble (sth.) up  
jumbles, jumbling, jumbled  
jumble up

(١) يَخْلُطُ الأَشْيَاءَ بِتَغْضُضِهَا بِلا نِظَامٍ.

e.g. His clothes were all jumbled up in the suit case (usually passive).

(٢) (الأفكار) تَخْتَلِطُ، تَتَشَوَّشُ (في عَقْلِهِ).

e.g. His thoughts seem to be jumbled up.

jump at (sth.)

jumps, jumping, jumped

jump at

يَتَلَهَّفُ عَلَى قَبُولِ (فُرْصَةٍ مَثَلًا).

e.g. I thought he'd jump at the offer, but he wasn't interested.

jump in

(١) يُقَاطِعُ شَخْصًا أَثناءَ الحَدِيثِ.

e.g. I wish you'd stop jumping in and finishing my sentences all the time.

(٢) تَتَدَخَّلُ فِي مَوْقِفٍ أَوْ مَشْرُوعٍ بِسُرْعَةٍ.

e.g. The record company jumped in with a multi million deal.

jump on (sb.) (عَامَّةً)

يَنقُدُ أَوْ يُهَاجِمُ (شَخْصًا).

e.g. She jumps on me for the smallest mistake.

jump out at (sb.)

(شَيْءٌ مَا) يَجْذِبُ انْتِبَاهَكَ فِي الحَالِ.

e.g. As I scanned the books on the shelf one of the titles jumped out at me.

jump up

نَقِيفَ فُجَاءَةً.

e.g. She jumped up and ran to the door.

jut out

juts, jutting, jutted

(السَّنَنُ) تَبْزُرُ تَنْتَأُ. (الجَبَلُ) يَرْتَفِعُ.

e.g. Gibraltar juts out from the southern side of Spain.
