e.g. We queued up to get tickets for the concert.

queue up to do (sth.)

بَتُّوقٍ. يَرْغَبُ بِشِدَّةٍ فِي عَمَلِ شَيْءٍ.

e.g. Some of the world's most respected musicians were queuing up to play with him.

يُسْرِعُ. تَتَسَارَعُ خُطْوَاتُهُ.

quicken up

e.g. He quickened up his pace.

quiet down (sb./ sth.) or quiet (sb./ sth.)
 quieten down (sb./ sth.) or
 quieten (sb./ sth.) down
quiets, quieting, quieted/ quietens,
quietening, quietened.

quiet, quieten down

(الضُّوْضَاءُ) تَهْدَأُ. تُسَكِّتُ. تُهَيِّئُ شَخْصًا أَوْ حَيَوَانًا.

e.g. The speaker tried to quiet down the audience.

quit on (sb.)

quits, quitting, quitted, quit

quit on

(أ) يَهْجُرُ شَخْصًا. يَنْزِكُ مَجْمُوعَةً كَأَن يَعْمَلَ مَعَهَا.
 يَتَخَلَّى عَنْ.

e.g. One of my staff has quit on me without any warning.

(أ) (أَلَّةٌ) تَتَوَقَّفُ عَنِ الْعَمَلِ (عَامَّةً).

e.g. If the motorcycle quits on him in Montana, he's in real trouble.
