

Chapter Three

The Idiomatic Use of Prepositions Phrasal Verbs

تنقسم حروف الجر التي تأتي بعد الأفعال إلى قسمين:

(١) حروف جر لا تغيّر معنى الفعل:

The train arrived at the station .

He's listening to the radio .

He goes to school by bus .

(٢) حروف جر تكون مع الأفعال تركيبات لغوية خاصة يتغير معها معنى الفعل المركب عن معنى الفعل بمفرده أو حرف الجر بمفرده، وتُسمى هذه الأفعال المركبة (phrasal verbs)

Put up	يبثت - يركب
Put on	يرتدى
Put out	يطفيئ (نارًا)
Take off	يخلع - تقلع (للطائرات)
Ring up	يتصل تليفونيا
Ring back	يعيد الاتصال تليفونيا
Pick up	يأخذ شيئًا من سيارته - يلتقط
Top up	يزود - يعلو

ويرتبط حرف الجر بفعله على صورتين:

أولاً: إذا كان المفعول اسمًا فإنه يوضع قبل أو بعد حرف الجر.

The carpenter put up the shelves .

The carpenter put the shelves up .

ثانيًا: إذا كان المفعول ضميرًا فإنه يُوضع قبل حرف الجر فقط.

The carpenter put them up .

Examples

Act on	(follow) يتبع	: I acted on your advice .
Back up	(support) يساند / يدعم	: They backed up their friend in what he said .
Blow up	(Explode) ينسف	: The thieves blew up the train .
B r e a k down	(to be out of order) يتعطل	: The washing machine has broken down again .
Break in	(entered by force) يسطو / يدخل بالقوة	: The thief broke in the bank .
Break out	(escape) يهرب	: The prisoner broke out of jail .
Break up	(break to pieces) (stop/scatter) يحطم / يوقف / يبعثر	: They broke up the ship for scrap . The police broke up the meeting .
Bring up	(raise children) يربي أطفالا	: She brought up a big family .
Burn down	(burnt to the ground) يحترق	: The hotel burnt down .
Call at	(visited) يزور	: He called at my house yesterday .
Call off	(cancel) يلغي	: The meeting has been called off .

Call up	(phoned) يتصل تليفونيا	: Smith called up this morning .
Carry out	(fulfilled) نفذ	: He carried out the orders in details .
Charge with	(accused of) اتهم بـ	: The man was charged with thieving .
Close down	(ceased business) يتوقف عن العمل	: The toys factory closed down .
Come across	(met by chance) يقابل بالصدفة	: She came across an old friend in Rome .
Come in	(arrived) يصل	: The train came in early .
Come in	(enter) يدخل	: Please come in and sit down .
Count on	(depend , rely on) يعتمد على	: May I count on your help?
Cry out	(shouted) يصيح / يصرخ	: They cried out when the bus passed them .
Cross off	(removed) يزيل	: They crossed off his name.
Cut down	(reduce) يقلل	: He tried to cut down his smoking .
Cut up	(stop) يتوقف عن	: I shall try to cut up smoking .
Cut up	(cut to pieces) يقطع	She cut up the apple into halves .
Deal with	(handle manage) يتعامل مع	: How do you deal with difficult situations ?
Draw up	(stopped) يتوقف	: The car drew up outside the police station .

What Do you Know about Prepositions?

Figure out	(understand) يفهم	: No one can figure out what he means .
Fill in	(write out) يملأ	: Do you know how to fill in this cheque ?
Find out	(discover) يكتشف	: They could not find out where he lived .
Get at	(annoy) يزعج / يضايق	: My wife is always getting at me . Ordering me around .
Get by	(manage) يتدبر الأمر	: I have no formal clothes for this occasion ; perhaps I can get by in a dark suit ,
Get on	(progress) يتقدم	: She's getting on well with her English lessons .
Get on	يركب	The train was so full that he couldn't get on .
Get over	(recovered from) يتغلب على / يُشفى من	: He soon got over his illness .
Get up	(rise)	: She always gets up at seven .
Give away	(give) يعطي / يهب	: You should give away your old clothes to the poor .
Give up	(stopped) يقلع	: He gave up smoking last week .
Go on	(what's happening) ماذا يحدث؟	: What's going on here ?
Go on	(continue)	Please , go on with your work .

Grow up	(was brought up) نشأت / ترعرعت	: She grew up in the country .
Hang up	(put the phone down) يضع سّاعة التليفون.	: She hung up on me .
Keep on	(continued) يستمر	: The baby kept on crying all night .
Laugh at	(be amused by) يضحك على	: We all laughed at the funny story .
Let down	(failed me) يخزل	: She promised to help but let me down .
Listen to	(try to hear) ينصت إلى	: The boy heard his father's voice but wasn't listening to what he was saying .
Look after	(took care of) يعتني بـ	: She looked after the baby while her mother was out.
Look for	(searching for) يبحث عن	: He is looking for his keys.
Look out	(take care) احترس	: Look out ! there's car coming .
Look up	(try to find) يبحث عن كلمة في قاموس	: I don't know the meaning of this word . I'll look it up in the dictionary .
Pass away	(died) يموت	: By the time we reached the hospital , the injured boy had passed away .
Pick up	(learned) يتعلم	: He picked up a lot of French when he was in France .

Pick up	(take hold of and left) يلتقط من على الأرض	: There is an apple on the floor . . Pick it up , please .
Put off	(postpone) يؤجّل	: we were to meet on Sunday , but it off .
Put on	(wear) يرتدي	: She put on your jacket ; it is very cold .
Put up	(accommodate) / يزور ياوي في فندق	: They put their parents up for the week-end .
Put up	(build) ينشأ	They put up tent in the garden .
Ring up	(telephone) يتصل	: I'll ring you up after dinner .
Send for	(to request the presence of) يستدعي	: We sent for the doctor when the child fell sick .
Set off	(being a long journey) ينطلق في رحلة	: They set off for Austria yesterday .
Sit down	يجلس	: Don't stand up , sit down , please !
Sleep in	ينام	: She doesn't go to work on Friday ; she sleeps in , instead .
Slow down	(reduced speed) يُبطئ السرعة	: The train slowed down at the conjunction .
Stand up	(rose) ينهض	: They stood up when the teacher entered the class .
Take off	(being a flight) تطلع	: The plane took off at four.
Take up	(occupy) تشغل حيّزًا	: The table takes up a lot of room .
Take up	(start) يبدأ	: She has taken up French lately .

Tell off	(blamed) يلوم	: The teacher told us off for making loud noise .
Try on	(to see if it fits) يقيس	: Can I try this jacket on ?
Turn down	(refuse/reject) يرفض	: He turned down their offer of \$ 100 .
Turn down	(lower) يخفض	: Turn the radio down , please ; the baby is asleep.
Turn off	(put out) يطفى	: Turn off the lights please .
Turn on	(switch on) يفتح	: Turn the lights on , please ; I can't see .
Turn up	(arrive) يصل	: It's five o'clock and she hasn't turned up yet .
Wake up	يوقظ	: Keep quiet please , you are going to wake the baby up .
Wait for	ينتظر	: I shall wait for you until you come .
Wait out	(became old) يبلى	: My shoes are worn out ; I must buy a new pair .
Work out	(estimate) يقدر	: I worked out that it would cost a hundred pounds to do the kitchen .
Work out	(solved) يحل	: They worked out the problem in five minutes .

Phrasal verbs with two particles :

Come up with	(suggested) يقترح	: He was silent all the time then came up with a good idea .
Go back on	(never breaks) لا يرجع في كلامه	: He is a trust worthy man . He never goes back on his promise .
Keep on at	(persuaded) يقنع	: He kept on at her until she agreed to marry him .
Keep up with	يساير/ يلحق بـ	: They were running so fast ; I couldn't keep up with them .
Look down on	(scorn) يحتقر	: He's snobbish ; he looks down on the poor people .
Put up with	(tolerate) يتحمل	I can't put up with my boss any more .
Run out of	(consume) نفذ ما لديه / يستهلك	: I ran out of cigarettes . I must get some .

Phrasal Verbs

الأفعال التي يأتي بعدها حرف جر

كثير من الأفعال في اللغة الإنجليزية تتحد مع حروف الجر في تغيير معناها، وتكون ما يعرف باسم التعبيرات، وهناك أربعة أنواع من هذه الأفعال:

١ . النوع الأول: يتبع الفعل فيه مفعول، ولا يمكن فصل حرف الجر فيه عن الفعل.

We believe in Allah .

I hope for success .

They are listening to music .

Water turns into ice when it freeze . تتجمد .

٢ . النوع الثاني: يتبع الفعل فيه مفعولا ، ويمكن فصل حرف الجر فيه عن الفعل.

I turned off the light .

I turned the light off .

He put on his new suit .

He put his new suit on .

٣ . النوع الثالث: لا يتبع الفعل فيه مفعولا ، ولا يمكن فصل حرف الجر فيه عن الفعل.

My car broke down تعطلت this morning .

Hurry up ! we're late for school .

Sit down , please .

The car pulled up توقفت suddenly .

٤ . النوع الرابع: يتبع الفعل فيه مفعولا ، ويتحد مع حرفي جر لا يمكن فصلهما عن الفعل.

They came down from the hill التل .

Keep out of the room .

He looked up at the plane as it was flying .

We shouldn't look down upon ختقر poor people .

ملحوظة :

عند تحويل جملة خبرية تحتوي على فعل يتحد مع حرف جر إلى سؤال يوضع حرف الجر في نهاية الجملة.

I am looking at the sky .

What are you looking at ?

He is waiting for his friend .

Who is waiting for ?

Examples :

Ask out

ask someone to go on a date .

يطلب من شخص موعداً للخروج سوياً.

We've been asked out to dinner twice this week

Bring about, bring on = cause يسبب

Land reform brought about a great change in the lives of the common people .

This incident will surely bring on a crisis.

Bring up = rear children يربي أولاداً

Every mother has to bring up her children properly

Mention or introduce a topic يفتح أو يبدأ موضوعاً (للحديث)

The students brought up the question of racial discrimination in class .

Bring off = to accomplish ينجز

The manager brought off a big business deal

Call back = return a telephone call يعاود الاتصال

The actor was called back for a second audition

Call in = to call upon for consultation; ask for help .

يطلب للاستشارة أو المساعدة

Two specialists were **called in** to assist in the operation

Call off = to cancel (something) that had been planned for a certain date .

يلغى شيئاً كان قد حدد له موعداً

The performance was **called off** because of rain

Call on = to visit **بِزور**

I like to **call on** friends

Call up = to communicate or try to communicate with by telephone .

يتصل بأحد على التليفون

I will **call him up** to ask about his health .

Catch up with = reach the same level or position .

يصل لنفس المستوى أو المركز.

They tried to **catch up with** the leader in a race .

Check in, check into = to register, as at a hotel .

يُسجّل حضوراً أو يحجز في فندق مثلاً.

We **checked in** at the reception desk .

Check out = take a book from a library .

يأخذ كتابًا من المكتبة (للاستعارة).

This book was checked out in your name

Investigate بدقق أو يفحص

The policeman checked out the validity of the driving license

Check out of = leave a hotel (يسجل خروج) يغادر الفندق

We checked out of the hotel this morning

Cheer up = make (someone) feel happier يُفرح أو يُسعد

This fine weather should cheer you up

Clean up = to wash or tidy up يُنظف ويُرتب

The maid cleaned up the house after the party

Come across = meet by chance يلتقي صدفة

I came across this picture when I was cleaning out the attic .

Cut out = stop an annoying activity .

يوقف أو ينهي شيئًا مزعجًا

Let's cut out the talking and get back to work .

Cut down = to lessen; decrease يخفف أو يقلل

The doctors have told me to cut down on between-meal snacks

Cut in = to drive into a space between cars in a dangerous way likely to cause an accident .

يقود بين سيارتين بشكل خطير قد يسبب حادثاً .

A speeding car cut in and nearly caused a crash .

Cut off = to stop suddenly; disconnect يتوقف فجأة أو يفصل .

We were cut off in the middle of our telephone conversation

Cut up = to cut into pieces or sections يقطع إلى قطع صغيرة .

The butcher cut up the chicken into small cubes .

Do over = do again يعيد العمل

Tom was not satisfied with the work so he did it over and over until it was good

Do without = dispense with يستغني عن

The store doesn't have any lemons, so you'll have to do without

Drop by, drop in = to stop in for a short visit .

يقوم بزيارة خاطفة أو سريعة.

Drop in and see us when you're come to London .

Drop off = to decrease **يقبل أو ينقص**

Sales dropped off in the fourth quarter

Drop out of to stop attending school for example or taking part .

يتوقف عن الحضور إلى المدرسة مثلا (يترك المدرسة) أو يتوقف عن المشاركة.

He dropped out of ordinary society because it was driving him mad

Face up to = admit to; take responsibility for .

يعترف أو يتحمل مسئولية

Sooner or later, you'll have to face up to the fact that you're failing it

Fall through = not happen for something that was planned .

لم يحدث شيء كان مخططاً له

We had originally intended to go to Mexico for our vacation, but our trip fell through when I got sick .

Figure out = to understand; solve .

يفهم أو يحل أو يعرف الحل عن طريق البرهان.

We couldn't figure out where all the money had gone .

Fill up = to complete by supplying missing or desired information .

يكمل وثيقة أو لائحة بتعبئة المعلومات الناقصة أو المطلوبة.

We had to fill up a form before we buy these machines .

Fill in = add information to a form يقوم بتعبئة معلومات

The office needs to know your home address and phone number.
Could you fill them in on this form ?

Fill in for = temporarily do someone else's work; temporarily substitute for another person .

يقوم بعمل لشخص آخر مؤقتًا أو يأخذ مكانًا آخر مؤقتًا.

At school, we have to fill in for absent teachers .

Find out = discover information

يكتشف أو يعرف معلومات.

I didn't find out about the meeting until just a few minutes ago

Get along with = have a friendly relationship with .

يقوم على علاقة جيدة بـ

Why can't you and your sister get along? Everyone else gets along with her just fine

Get around = avoid having to do something .

يتجنب القيام بعمل ما .

Eman got around the required math classes by doing well on a math proficiency test .

Get away with = to accomplish without punishment .

يقوم بعمل خاطئ من دون التعرض لعقاب .

Some people lie and cheat and always seem to get away with it .

Get back from = return from a place . يرجع من مكان .

We got back from Paris this morning

Get in; get into = enter يدخل

She got in her car and drove away

Get off = to leave (a train, plane, etc.); dismount from a horse .

ينزل من السيارة أو القطار إلخ أو ينزل من على الحصان .

When you get off the bus, cross the street and you will be there .

Get on = enter an airplane, a bus, a train, etc .

يركب طائرة، حافلة، قطار، إلخ .

He got on the train and waved for us to leave .

Get out of = escape having to do something .

يتهرب من القيام بعمل ما .

Lisa said she had a terrible headache and got out of giving her speech today .

Get over = recover from an illness or painful experience.

يتغلب على مرض أو تجربة مؤلمة.

She thought she would never get over feeling so stupid .

Get rid of = dispose of يتخلص من

That shirt is really ugly. Why don't you get rid of it

Get through = to complete; finish يُنجز أو ينهي

How he ever got through college is a mystery

Get up = arise from bed, a chair .

بينهض من السرير أو بيقوم عن الكرسي .

You'll have to get up much earlier than usual tomorrow .

Give back = return an item to someone . يعيد غرضاً لشخص ما

You haven't given back the books you borrowed from me .

Give up = stop trying يستسلم

He gave up trying to get an answer

Go over = review or check carefully . يراجع أو يفحص بدقة .

Jack went over the paper checking for any spelling mistakes

Go through = experience يعيش تجربة

Mary went through a lot of troubles .

Grow up = become an adult ينضج

behave as an adult, not a child يتصرف بعقلانية

Aly really irritates me sometimes. He's really silly and childish. I wish he would grow up .

Hand in = submit homework, an assignment, etc .

يسلم فرضاً أو واجباً .

You have to hand the report in at 8:30 tomorrow morning

Hand out = distribute يوزع

The teacher handed out the test papers today

Hang up = end a phone conversation by replacing the receiver .

ينتهي مكالمة هاتفية بوضع السماعة في مكانها

I'd like to talk longer, but I'd better hang up. My sister needs to make a call .

Have to do with = be about يتعلق بـ

This class has to do with the behavior of people in groups .

Have on = wear يلبس

He had on his jacket and left

Hold up = delay يُؤخر

I'm sorry I'm late. There was an accident on the freeway and traffic held me up

Iron out = reach an agreement يصل إلى اتفاق

I know we disagree on lots of things, Susan, but we can iron them out .

Keep on = continue يتابع أو يستمر

I'm not ready to stop yet. I think I'll keep on working for a while .

Keep out of = not enter يمنع من الدخول

There is broken glass in the room so keep the child out of it .

Keep up with = stay at the same position or level .

يساير / يواكب

Internet addicts keep up with the newest updates .

Kick out = expel ; force someone to leave .

يطرد أو يجبر على المغادرة.

Samy's club kicked him out because he didn't pay his dues or come to meetings .

Knock out = make unconscious يغيب عن الوعي

The boxing match ended when one boxer knocked the other one out .

Leave out = forget ينسى إضافة شيء

Oh, no! When I made the list of those who attended the meeting, I left your name out .

Let down = disappoint يخيب أمل

I know I let you down when I didn't do what I promised. I'm really sorry .

Look after = take care of يعتني

The babysitter had to look after the baby for two hours

Look back on = remember يفكر في الماضي

When they looked back on their many years together, they realized that their marriage had been a very happy one .

Look down on = hold in contempt .

ينظر إلى على أنه أدنى، يستحق.

He seems to look down on anyone who doesn't like the same things that he does .

Look forward to = anticipate pleasantly .

تطلع إلى أو ينظر بشوق.

I'm really looking forward to vacation. I can't wait for it to begin .

Look into = investigate / get more details about something

يتحقق أو يتأكد

Someone said there was a meeting at 9:30 but I haven't heard anything about it. Shall I look into it

Look like = resemble يشبه

Does he look like his father or his mother

Look out for = be careful يأخذ حذره أو ينتبه

He has to look out for his health

Look over = to examine, esp. briefly يفحص

I think I may have some typos مطبعية غلطات in this report. Could you look it over .

Look up = look for information in a reference book .

بحث عن معلومات في دليل.

Look up the answer in the encyclopedia .

Look up to = to regard with admiration or respect .

ينظر باحترام وتقدير.

A boy needs a father he can look up to

Make up = invent يألف من نسج الخيال

Judy's story is hard to believe. I'm sure she made it up

Make fun of = make jokes about يستهزئ أو يسخر

I agree that Bob looks ridiculous since he shaved his head, but don't make fun of him. You'll hurt his feelings .

Name after, name for = give a baby the name of someone else

يطلق على طفل اسمًا لشخص آخر

Ahmed was named after his uncle .

Pass away = die مات

I was very sorry to hear that your grandfather passed away .

Pass out = distribute يوزع

Everyone in the room needs one of these information sheets. Who will help me pass them out .

Pass out = faint; lose consciousness

يفغى عليه أو يفقد الوعي

When Mona heard that she'd won a million dollars, she was so shocked that she passed out

Pick out = choose; select يختار أو ينتقي

Billy's grandmother especially liked her birthday card because Billy had picked it out himself .

Pick up = lift; take up يرفع

Those books don't belong on the floor. Will you help me pick them up .

Point out = call attention to يلفت الانتباه إلى

She pointed out an error in our reasoning .

Pull over = drive a vehicle to the side of the road .

يقود إلى جانب الطريق.

When the policeman indicated that I should pull over, I knew he was going to give me a ticket .

Put away = remove to a proper place .

ينقل إلى المكان المناسب

I just took these clothes out of the dryer. Will you help me put them away .

Put back = return to original place **يعيد إلى مكانه الأساسي**

Mom put back my books on the shelf after she finished cleaning

Put off = postpone; delay **يؤجل أو يؤخر**

I keep asking for an appointment, but he keeps putting me off .

Put on = to wear **يلبس**

It's a little bit chilly outside. You'd better put a sweater on .

Put out = extinguish a cigarette **يطفيئ السيجارة**

Aly had to put out the cigarette when he saw his father passing by his room .

Put up with = tolerate **يتحمل**

It's really important to come to work on time. The boss won't put up with tardiness .

Run into; across = meet by chance **يلتقي صدفة**

Yesterday at the supermarket, Eman ran into her former roommate. Before yesterday .

Run out of = finish a supply of something **ينفذ من**

On the way home from work, Art ran out of gas .

Set up = make arrangements for something .

يقوم بتدابير لشيء ما .

You'll see Mr. Amer tomorrow. I've set a meeting up for 9:30 AM

Show up = arrive; appear **يصل أو يظهر**

The boss was very upset when you didn't show up for the meeting

Stand for = represent **يمثل**

These letters seem to be an abbreviation. Do you know what they stand for.

Take after = resemble **يشبه**

Both my sister and I take after our father

Take off = remove something you're wearing **يخلع ملابسه**

Please take your hat off when you go inside a building .

Take off = leave; depart **يُغادر أو يُقَلع**

When does your plane take off

Take up = begin a new activity or topic .

يبدأ نشاطاً أو هواية جديدة.

I've never been skiing, but I think I'd like to take it up

Tear down = destroy; demolish **يدمر**

The explosion tore down the whole building

Tear up = to tear into small shreds .

يُنزق إلى قطع صغيرة جدًا .

He tore up the drawings because she had criticized them .

Throw away = discard; put in the garbage . يرمي في النفايات

You shouldn't throw those newspapers away; they're recyclable

Throw up = vomit يتقيأ

Aly was so nervous about his job interview that he threw up just before he left for it .

Try on = wear something briefly to check its fit, how it looks .

يُجَرَّب ملابس

I'm not sure that jacket is large enough. May I try it on .

Turn down = decrease the volume خفض الصوت

Your music is giving me a headache! Please turn it down or use your headphones .

Turn down = refuse يرفض

I thought I could borrow some money from Adel, but when I asked, he turned me down .

Turn in = go to bed يذهب للنوم

I'm pretty tired. I guess I'll turn in .

Turn in submit an assignment يسلم واجب

I've written my report, but I haven't turned it in .

Turn off = stop a machine يوقف آلة

I'm cold. Do you mind if I turn the air conditioner off

Turn on = begin a machine يشغل آلة

It's cold in here. I'm going to turn the heater on

Turn up = increase the volume يعلي الصوت

I can barely hear the TV. Can you turn it up a little .

Turn up = appear unexpectedly يظهر أو يأتي فجأة

We were all surprised when Pam turned up at the party. We didn't even know she was in town .

Act up = behave badly يتصرف بطريقة غير لائقة

Sophie got bored and started acting up .

Add up = to calculate the total of two or more numbers .

يجمع أو يحسب

If you add those four figures up, it comes to over £500. She added the bill up . I'm not very good at adding up .

Add up to = to become a particular amount .

يبلغ كمية أو حد معين.

The various building programmes add up to several thousand new homes .

We thought we'd bought lots of food, but it didn't add up to much when we'd spread it out on the table .

Ask somebody in = to invite someone to come into a building or room, especially your home .

يدعو شخصًا للدخول إلى مبنى، غرفة أو منزل.

I'd ask you in for a coffee but I have to get up early for work in the morning .

Ask after somebody = to ask for information about someone, especially about their health .

يستعلم عن شخص ما وخاصة عن صحته.

Tell your father I was asking after him .

Ask around = to ask a lot of different people in order to get information or help .

يسأل الكثير من الأشخاص للحصول على معلومات أو لمساعدة.

Our babysitter's just moved away, so we're asking around for a replacement

Back away = to move backwards away from something or someone, usually because you are frightened .

يرجع إلى الخلف بسبب الخوف خاصة.

She saw that he had a gun and backed away

Back down = to admit that you were wrong or that you have been defeated .

يعترف بالخطأ أو الهزيمة.

Eventually, Ramzy backed down and apologized .

Local residents have forced the local council to back down from/on its plans to build a nightclub in their street.

Back off = to stop being involved in a situation, usually in order to allow other people to deal with it themselves .

ينسحب أو يتوقف عن.

She started to criticize me, then she suddenly backed off.

Just back off and let us do this on our own, will you?

Back off = to move backwards away from someone, usually because you are frightened .

يرجع إلى الخلف بسبب الخوف خاصة.

I saw the knife and backed off

Back onto something = faces something from the back.

يقابل، ولكن من الجهة الخلفية وليس الأمامية.

The house backs onto a narrow alley زقاق / حارة

Back out = to decide not to do something that you had said you would do .

يقرّر عدم القيام بعمل قال مسبقاً أنه سيقوم به.

You agreed to come. You can't back out now .

They backed out of the deal the day before they were due to sign the contract .

Back somebody up = to support or help someone .

يدعم أو يساعد.

My family backed me up throughout the court case .

Back something up = to prove something is true .

يثبت صحة شيء ما .

His claims are backed up by recent research .

Beat down = sun shines very strongly and makes the air very hot .

Beat somebody down = to persuade someone to accept a lower amount of money for something .
